MINARI lacked speed, hugged the inner rail entering the far turn, eased out and was taken to the four path in upper stretch, closed outside horses and gained the lead approaching the finish. LEARNING TO FLY prompted the pace outside STEAM KNOT, took the lead in upper stretch went clear in mid stretch and gave way grudgingly. DIRTY GOLD, steadied in traffic mid way on the first turn, rated down the backstretch and on the far turn, entered the stretch in the two path and rallied inside horses. LAUGHING FIT trailed for six furlongs, raced outside horses in the stretch and passed tired ones. BALLROOM EYES stalked the pace near the inner rail, eased out turning for home, had aim on the lead in mid stretch and weakened. KEEP IT SWEET, five deep on the far turn, failed to be a factor. STEAM KNOT set the pace along the inner rail, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way approaching the eighth pole. SHORT SKIRTS, four wide the far turn, gave way, pulled up lame on the gallop out and was transported off the track by the equine ambulance. HOUSE ALERT, four wide the first turn, raced in the three path on the far turn and gave way. LADY LYNX stayed between horses much of the race and gave way entering the stretch.

SIR MICK, brushed at the break, was gunned up between rivals to take command about three wide, took outer pressure into the turn, maintained a narrow advantage two wide under coaxing past the five sixteenths, fought on between rivals entering the lane, emerged in a tussle outside KISSLING leaving the three sixteenths, shook clear of that one while under a stout drive a sixteenth out then held firm to the wire. BUOYANT broke outward brushing with the winner, corrected and edged up four wide under a ride heading to the half mile marker, was under pressure to remain in range while continuing wide past the five sixteenths, circled four wide into the lane and kept on with effort to gain the place. FREEDOM STANCE broke a step slow, raced off the pace while saving ground, advanced to the inside of a rival leaving the three eighths, shifted out approaching the stretch, came back for the final furlong and churned on. SUPREME MIND moved up four then three wide to engage the winner from his outside, vied around the turn, failed to initially guicken with the leading pair in upper stretch but kept on with effort. KISSLING stalked inside while nudged along, slipped through towards the inner rail to engage the leading pair leaving the quarter pole, dueled inside the winner past mid stretch, faded with about seventy yards remaining and drifted late. BAD BOY BLAZE flashed speed, was outsprinted nearing the half, steadied when losing action soon after, dropped back, regrouped and failed to make a serious recovery through the drive. BISHOP MEADE, urged along around the turn, failed to menace.

AFRICAN WATERS, three wide the first turn, chased the pace, took the lead outside REPPAZZ in upper stretch, failed to hold off the winner but finished well clear of the others. DIAMOND SUE, off the pace while between rivals into the turn, dropped inside and moved up inside rivals while shoved along past the five sixteenths pole, worked outward into the lane and set her sights on the leader, closed in steadily under a drive and moved to engage inside the furlong grounds, took command about seventy yards out and drew clear. HOT ROUTE, with the early pace four wide, bid outside the leader near the half, vied under rating mid turn, took to rousing and moved clear past the three sixteenths, dug in a bit when confronted by an outer rival past mid stretch, gave way grudgingly and saved the place. LADY SRIRACHA, away alertly, pursued off the inside then three deep mid turn, shifted four wide for the drive, churned on and gained the show in the final yards. BOYS GO TO JUPITER stayed along the inner rail most of the race and failed to rally. DELAYED, four deep leaving the back stretch, worked between horses in the stretch, steadied in close quarters near the sixteenth pole then finished with energy. SECURE'S HOPE, unhurried down the backstretch, raced in the two path far turn, angled out and failed to menace. SMILINGONTHEINSIDE brushed with JUICE leaving the starting gate then was outrun. WIKOLIA LADY, rated outside horses early, advanced four wide leaving the backstretch and tired. DRINK DEEPLY chased the pace three wide on the far turn and gave way.

MOSE PERFECT relaxed four wide in range early on, advanced under a hustling ride and outside rivals past the three eighths, kept on grinding under pressure and moved up to bid outside foes leaving the eighth pole, emerged in a head to head battle outside UNION FLEET for the final seventy yards, kept on under right handed pressure and got the perfect bob at the wire. UNION FLEET drafted back and settled off the early pace, edged up between foes heading towards the turn, dropped in mid turn, angled out approaching the stretch, worked back in then out past the three sixteenths, bid between rivals leaving mid stretch, dueled on a slim lead to the inside of MOSE PERFECT past the sixteenth marker, continued on gamely but got the short end of the nose bob. SPLENDOR BEAUTY cleared early and set the pace two wide, shifted in under a drive and maintained command towards mid stretch, could not contain outer bids near the sixteenth marker and faded. THREE CAPTAINS, off the pace while saving ground, came under a solid ride leaving the far turn, remained towards the inside and offered a mild kick. JARDANI lagged off the pace, raced four wide into the lane, shifted out and had belated action. WALK AWAY JOE was checked between rivals leaving the five eighths, angled very wide through the drive and failed to menace. TOPS THE CHART prompted the pace three wide and between rivals, was shoved along giving futile pace into the lane and weakened. HARD SPUN FANTASY, three wide outside a rival mid turn, failed to respond. CAJUN DREAM edged up early and stalked the pace while saving ground, eased out for the drive, failed to kick on past the three sixteenths and weakened.

TURF ROCKET stalked the pace inside horses down the backstretch, eased out to the three path leaving the far turn, took the lead in upper stretch, drifted in and gave way grudgingly. VICTORY BADGE, three wide the first turn, circled the far turn four deep and had a slight rally. CHA CHA TAP lacked speed, raced in the two path on the far turn, swung wide in upper stretch and passed tired horses. BILOXI BLUES, rank for much of the opening quarter mile, raced along the inner rail and failed to be a factor. DEAD SEXY bumped with the winner at the start, trailed to the stretch then passed tired rivals. VIENNESE WALTZ, three deep chasing the pace down the backstretch and on the far turn, weakened. MISS AMAZING, rank along the inner rail entering the first turn, remained inside horses and failed to be a factor. GLOSSAMER prompted the pace outside LADY D'ORO, was checked in tight quarters inside the three sixteenths pole dropped back and was eased. embattled foes in mid stretch then drew away while kept alert. PRIZE DEBATE, two wide with early pursuit of the duel, dropped inside around the turn, slipped through along the inner rail to advance in mid stretch, failed to quicken on with the winner but kept on willingly to earn the place. LADY CHARLOTTE got into a pace scrum outside NEOLITHICA leaving the chute, carried that battled through intense fractions into and around the turn, stayed on while vying three wide and between runners past the three sixteenths then gave way grudgingly through the final sixteenth. KITTY'S PRETTY broke outward bumping a rival, corrected to chase four wide, was under a ride angling wider in upper stretch but failed to generate a solid late kick. NEOLITHICA showed sharp speed on a pressured lead inside, sparred around the turn and into the lane, drifted a bit past the three sixteenths, fought on past mid stretch then weakened very late.
