STRAIGHT TO WATER stayed along the inner rail stalking the duel, eased out to the three path entering the stretch, gained the lead outside the duelers in mid stretch and drew clear under steady handling. CHANCE , bumped and pinched back leaving the starting gate, was four wide approaching the stretch, floated to the six path in upper stretch and flattened out. SCHRADER disputed the pace outside SHADOW SURGE through fast fractions, weakened and drifted out late. SHADOW SURGE hugged the inner rail, dueled to upper stretch and tired. SPEEDY ALEX , three wide off the duel around the turn, gave way in the stretch. TINY LAKE came out leaving the starting gate, raced i nthe two path between horses on the turn and dropped back through the stretch.

FAN CLUB prompted the pace three wide, was put to pressure as the leaders got away leaving the far turn, dropped inside and was under a hearty ride pursuing a duel into the lane, picked things back up and moved through along the rail to forge to command a furlong out, spurted clear under left handed asking with a sixteenth to go then dug in late to deny BOLD ENDEAVOR. BOLD ENDEAVOR had speed inside then rated back off the leader nearing the seven eighths, angled out for the backstretch run then edged up to prompt, disputed the pace outside MASAKADO from the half mile marker, was floated out while taking a slim lead into the lane, dug back in after ceding the lead to the inner winner and came back gamely through the final yards. MASAKADO bore in sharply at the break then had to be taken off of a rival, corrected and was nudged up to take command and cleared seven furlongs out, was joined from the outside near the five eighths, clung to command while drifting past the quarter pole, fought on between foes nearing mid stretch then weakened. MASTER OF NONE steadied when bothered by MASAKADO at the break, regrouped and saved ground, edged up some nearing the five furlong marker, angled out nearing the quarter pole but failed to generate a rally. CATATUMBO lost ground four wide to the half mile marker, failed to respond leaving the far turn and weakened.

ON A PROUD NOTE prompted the pace outside LOST RIVER, overtook that one in upper stretch, stayed on his left lead until approaching the sixteenth pole and drew off under urging. BOND'S BELLE chased outside horses, circled the turn three wide and weakened through the stretch. LOST RIVER hugged the inner rail setting a pressured pace and gave way the final furlong. BUGGED OUT saved ground around the turn, eased off the rail for the drive and was not a factor. FEELIN SO LUCKY lacked speed, raced three wide on the turn, angled wider in upper stretch and was no factor. INFASTUATION trailed.

LINO'S FIRE , patiently handled off the pace while saving ground, his rider remained chilly past the three eighths, was afforded a clear rail run soon into the lane, bid inside rivals leaving the furlong grounds, wrested command from an outer foe leaving the sixteenth pole, kept on under solid encouragement and held firm. GREYLINE STATION broke a step slow, regrouped and was taken to rate, edged up into the turn, worked his way between foes then poked a head in front inside the eighth pole, switched over his correct lead after meeting the winner's bid then gave way grudgingly. FINNY cleared early, set a rated pace off the inside, dug in when confronted by an outer foe mid turn, drifted to the five path while maintaining command into the lane, straightened away, ceded to inner rivals past mid stretch and faded. IN THE DANCE , forwardly placed between rivals leaving the chute, drafted back off the pace a sixteenth later and saved ground, was put to a strong ride nearing mid turn, angled five wide into the lane, straightened away and leveled off under a drive, rolled past inner foes nearing the furlong grounds then steadily widened while kept to task. CRAB DADDY , bumped at the break, prompted the pace three wide outside the leader, threatened in upper stretch, chased on between runners in mid stretch and held well. FORMAL AFFAIR , up close four wide and under some rating heading to the turn, was put to a serious ride mid turn, remained about four wide into the stretch, ranged up leaving the quarter pole and churned on. CARVELLIAN QUEST bobbled a stride out then bumped with an outer foe, regrouped and took over outside foes, cleared near the three quarter pole, set the pace off the inside, was hounded soon into the lane, stayed on willingly to deep stretch then faded. ALL THE HARDWAYS edged up between rivals early then dropped inside to track the pace, loomed under some rating past the three eighths, moved up some nearing the eighth pole, failed to kick on from there and weakened. HOT ROD KITTY broke a bit slow, was used early to reach contention leaving the chute, angled out then failed to drum up a run.
