LA VONDA SECURITY rated off of the early pace, tracked the leading pair three wide along the backstretch, bid into the far turn then vied for the lead nearing the quarter, battled between foes to upper stretch, was no match late for the winner but was a clear second best. GLORY ALL THE TIME showed early speed, pressed the pace outside of EVIL TOM into the backstretch, disputed the pace to the far turn then vied into the far turn, yielded to the top pair in the drive and was a clear third. EVIL TOM sent to take early command, set a pressured pace to the half-mile, overtaken into the far turn and faded in the stretch.

YO SOY ROY reserved in the early stages, roused between rivals and two wide into the turn, bid three wide to upper stretch, drifted out under left handed urging and floated out a rival into the lane, took command into the final furlong, drove clear late while kept to task. MR JAWS sent to assume early command, set a pressured pace while two wide into the turn, led to the quarter marker then dug in into upper stretch, overtaken by YO SOY ROY at the furlong grounds, could not keep pace with the winner to the final sixteenth but saved second. CHAMPAGNE STOOOPER allowed to settle early on, gained ground while widest into the turn, coaxed four wide to the quarter marker, got floated to the five to six path into upper stretch, recovered and stayed on to the final sixteenth, could not match strides late with the winner and just missed for second. PAINTED LAD was forwardly placed in the early going, went up to press the pace from the inside heading into the turn, disputed the pace to the quarter, chased into upper stretch then outkicked at the furlong grounds, could not find more to the final sixteenth and weakened late. SAMSPLAYERSLOUNGE hustled leaving the start, tracked the early leaders along the backstretch, saved ground into the turn then lost ground nearing the quarter marker, lacked a response to upper stretch, tired in the lane.

MELLENCAMP stumbled at the start, recovered to track the early pace from the inside, saved ground into the turn then caught in tight at the quarter marker, weaved through rivals into upper stretch, responded well past mid-stretch, took command in deep stretch and proved best late. WISE DECISION sent for the early lead, set a contested pace from the inside heading into the turn, carved out decent fractions to the quarter marker, led to upper stretch then dug in into the final furlong, could not match strides with the winner into the final sixteenth and just held for second. SANDS OF TIME settled in the second flight to begin, went up to stalk the pace three deep along the backstretch, well placed to the quarter pole, gave chase three wide into the stretch, battled into the final sixteenth, was outkicked in deep stretch and just missed for second, while clear for third. TAPCON a step slow away from the start, lacked early speed and trailed into the turn, saved ground into the bend then angled four to five wide for the stretch drive, was gaining late but could not reel in the leaders in deep stretch. WASTED WARRIOR broke alertly, vied for the early lead then pressed the pace from outside of WISE DECISION, attended to the decent pace two wide into the turn, chased between rivals past the quarter marker then caught a bit in tight to upper stretch, lost ground at the furlong pole, gave way late. SKY SIMON settled in the second flight to begin, lost ground into the turn, coaxed from the three to four path nearing the quarter, swung widest to upper stretch, lacked a response in the lane and tired. THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE RUNNING IN UPPER STRETCH. THE STEWARDS RULED THERE WOULD BE NO CHANGE.

WHISKEY HIGH off a step slowly, showed good speed away from the start and took early command, dictated terms through moderate fractions into the turn, kicked clear to upper stretch, drew off into the final furlong, held sway to the final sixteenth and was geared down late to win as much the best. RECLUSIVE was forwardly placed in the early running, took back and was well placed while saving ground approaching the turn, kept an inside path to the quarter pole, chased from the inside to upper stretch, was no match for the winner into the drive, fought on and held well late for second. MARCUS GIFT hopped then crowded at the start and last away from the gate, settled in the early going, coaxed three wide along the backstretch, weaved through foes along the far turn then mounted a four wide bid to upper stretch, responded well in the drive, surged late, up in time. HELICITY forwardly placed early, settled in the second flight then tracked three deep along the backstretch, loomed four wide into the far turn, vied for the lead to upper stretch and took command into the final furlong, led to the final sixteenth, was caught late by the oncoming winner and was clear of the rest for second. GOLD FRONT broke alertly, showed good early speed then disputed the pace to the first turn, contested solid fractions to the half-mile, showed the way into the far turn then dug in into upper stretch, yielded to the top pair into the final sixteenth and just held for third at the wire. ABSOLUTELY CERTAIN caught a bit in tight approaching the first turn and shuffled back into that bend, settled into the backstretch, trailed at the three-eighths, navigated traffic to upper stretch, rallied four wide into the final furlong, closed willingly late and just missed for third at the wire. HEDGE THE RISK off a bit slow to begin and unhurried to the first turn, saved ground along the backstretch, saved all of the ground to the far turn, steadied while on heels nearing the top of the lane, weaved through foes into the final furlong, found her best stride late but could not reel in the leaders in deep stretch. DOWN THE ISLANDS settled off of the early pace,

saved ground to the backstretch and tracked the solid pace to the half-mile, well placed into the far turn, chased from the two path into upper stretch, was outkicked to the furlong grounds, flattened out late. AUSTIN CRUISE settled between foes into the first turn, got shuffled back into the backstretch, saved ground into the far turn, kept an inside path to the far turn then was caught in tight nearing the quarter pole, chased from the inside into the stretch, lacked a final kick and finished evenly. MISS MOZETTI was forwardly placed away from the start, went up to press the pace from the outside along the backstretch, chased three wide into the far turn, lacked the needed response to upper stretch then gave way. SHOGUN settled in the second flight and four wide early on, tracked the solid pace while widest along the backstretch, ran in pursuit five wide into the far turn, lacked the needed response nearing the top of the stretch then weakened in the drive. HILLBILLY UP away in good order and close up to the early pace, chased the leading pair two wide and between foes into the backstretch run, ran in pursuit to the quarter pole, got shuffled back nearing the quarter marker and dropped back into upper stretch, came up empty in the drive and was not persevered with late.
