TI CAILLOU steadied a bit at the start, raced off the rail, off the pace, angled out in upper stretch, commenced a late rally outside, closed willingly and was up late for the win. SUMMER HELP stalked close up two wide, then pressed the pace, bid on the far turn, dueled, led, kicked clear in upper stretch, dug in gamely and was caught late. DON'T BACKDOWN fractious in the gate, tracked on the inside, chased two wide on the far turn, moved up four wide at the quarter pole and rallied for third. KING ARTHUR RIDGE raced off the pace inside, angled out in the stretch, rallied mildly between horses and got fourth. ADGER raced off the pace with an inside trip, lacked a bid and finished evenly. MISTER MOSCATO stalked two wide early, then tracked, chased on the far turn, went three wide past the quarter pole and weakened. MORO MAFIA raced off the rail, off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and tired. GHURAIR'S WARRIOR raced two wide off the pace, went four wide past the quarter pole and lacked a rally. ECHO MARINE pulled a bit in the early stages, set the pace on the inside, dueled on the far turn and faded.
