CASSATION chased two wide, chased on the turn, bid at the eighth pole and dug in between rivals to the finish. SMUGGLER'S GOLD raced three wide off the pace, saved ground on the turn and rallied mildly between horses in the final furlong. VESPARO was bumped at the start, raced off the pace inside, angled out into the stretch and rallied mildly outside. GO YOSHIDA bobbled and was bumped at the start, stalked the pace, bid three wide on the turn, put a head in front, responded when asked in upper stretch, drew clear, was ridden out and in hand late. CHANGE YOUR NAME raced three wide off the pace, made a four wide run into contention on the turn, bid at the quarter pole, dueled briefly, drifted in a path at the furlong marker and rallied for second. DAVE THE GREAT set the pace on the inside, dueled inside rivals at the quarter pole, drifted out at the eighth pole, weakened and held third. MINE SEEKER stalked two wide, chased between rivals on the turn, lacked room entering the stretch and again at the furlong marker, then angled to the inside and continued evenly. PRIME MOTIVE was bumped at the start, raced off the pace between rivals, behind horses entering the stretch, then checked in tight between horses at the furlong marker. MIDNIGHT LEGEND raced off the pace inside, chased on the turn and failed to threaten. After a Stewards' Inquiry into the stretch run, along with a Jockey Objection by the rider of PRIME MOTIVE against the second place finisher, DAVE THE GREAT was disqualified and placed fifth for causing the crowding in midstretch.
