REDEMPTION SPEIGHT tracked on the inside, saved ground on the far turn, lacked room at the furlong marker, then rallied mildly in the two path in the final sixteenth. WE LIVE THIS GAME was bumped at the start, raced off the pace, moved up three wide on the far turn, bid in upper stretch and was outkicked. REPEAT BUSINESS was bumped at the start, raced two wide off the pace, then inside, came three wide into the lane and closed belatedly. AUTHENTIC HONOUR raced two wide off the pace, then three wide, chased three wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. GENUINE GOMO was bumped at the start, raced off the pace on the inside, steadied midway on the far turn, steadied again on the inside at the eighth pole, then tired. TARTARIAN stalked two wide, chased on the far turn and faded. NOT A DIME BACK was off slowly and outrun.
