ALLISON PARK vied three wide early, then two wide, shook free nearing the quarter pole, responded when roused, kicked clear and held well under urging. GOLDEN RING raced off the pace with an inside trip, moved up entering the stretch, angled out in midstretch and closed well outside for second. CORACLE stalked close up three wide, chased between rivals on the turn, rallied between horses in the stretch, dug in to the finish and earned the show spot. ONE FINE WINE tracked on the inside, chased inside on the turn and rallied on the rail in the stretch run. LET HER RUN vied inside for the lead, chased midway on the turn, dug in and weakened late. SUMMER FLOWER raced off the pace, chased on the turn, came two wide into the lane, angled out

and closed late. RICHIE'S VALENTINE raced off the pace with an inside trip and finished evenly. SEA MAIDEN raced five wide early, stalked outside, chased three wide on the turn, came four wide into the lane and weakened. I CAN EXPLAIN steadied in the chute, then steadied again between rivals at the half mile marker, continued between horses on the turn, came five wide into the lane and weakened. POSTINO'S PROPHECY raced five wide early, then chased four wide, came five wide into the lane and weakened. DELIGHTFUL AVA trailed the field, came six wide into the lane and did not factor. YES MY LADY LINO broke awkwardly and was checked, then had a four wide trip, came six wide into the lane and faded.
