ELUSIVE D'ORO tracked close up on the inside, chased on the turn, rallied three wide past the quarter pole, dueled to midstretch, gained command, edged away and then held well under urging. JAKE ROCKS stalked close up two wide, bid two wide on the turn, dueled into the stretch, then dug in gamely inside of the winner in the final sixteenth. MY MAMBA raced off the pace inside, was in a bit tight entering the turn, then chased inside, made a rail bid at the top of the stretch and was outkicked. COBBLE ROAD set the pace, dueled inside rivals on the turn and tired. AWESOME ENTRY raced off the pace, chased three wide on the turn, came five wide into the lane and lacked a rally.
