SOUPER AMUSING pulled in the early stages, then settled in a nice tracking position, steadied entering the far turn, bid three wide on the turn, dueled, put a head in front, responded when roused in upper stretch, finished willingly and kicked clear. AUTHENTICATE NOW was bumped at the start, raced off the pace inside, advanced on the far turn, then steadied behind rivals at the five sixteenths, moved up, rallied outside in the stretch but second best. MIA VITA dueled inside for command, dueled on the far turn, dug in gamely inside of the winner in upper stretch and stayed on well to earn the show award. TOWER TWENTY TWO was bumped at the start, raced off the pace with an inside trip, closed mildly and bested the others. MISS RUMMIKUB (FR) raced off the rail, off the pace, between rivals on the far turn, came three wide into the lane and failed to threaten. C C GIRL trailed on the inside, moved up at the quarter pole, rode the rail into the stretch and lacked a rally. DELAYED raced two wide off the pace, went three wide on the backside, four wide on the far turn and tired.
