LAST GLORY raced three wide early, settled off the leaders, tracked those rivals on the far turn, bid three wide near the quarter pole, quickly took over and pulled away under urging. UMBRAL vied inside for the lead, then dueled with DAME CATHERINE on the backside and far turn, dug in through the stretch to earn the place spot. DAME CATHERINE vied outside for the lead, dueled on the backside and far turn and weakened in the stretch. HEAVENS EXPRESS raced off the pace inside, chased on the far turn and failed to threaten. SHOOPHEREITIS raced four wide early, settled off the rail, off the pace and failed to respond. SUBWAY SUSIE was outrun.
