INDY'S HOPE unhurried in the early going to trail, rallied five wide on the turn to loom at the quarter pole, was carried further wide at the top of the lane and flattned out in upper stretch. FORMYBOYS dueled on the lead from between rivals to midway on the turn, took a brief lead approaching the quarter pole and tired down the stretch. DUDE THE LEGEND flashed speed from the inside to the turn and came up empty. LUCKY KATER was outrun.

VERNON'S BEST stalked the pace from the inside through the turn, rallied turning for home, took up sharply in mid-stretch to angle to the clear around the tiring pacesetters and surged in the final sixteenth to be clear at the wire. FLARING SONG tracked the leaders through the turn, rallied six wide down the lane to be gaining late and be up for the place. BUMPER STICKER slow early to be the trailer, comenced a steady advance on the turn to circle the field and was gaining belatedly in the lane. MISTER ZAZU was erratic early weaving in and out through the chute, straightened away to press the pacesetter into the turn, battled with that one in upper stretch to take a brief lead inisde the eighth pole and weakened late. RED CHIPS showed speed to open a clear lead in the early going, battled under pressure on the lead through upper stretch and tired in the final eighth. HIDDEN HEART went evenly never posing a threat. SKUNK APE was not a factor.
