MAKING ME CRAZY broke with the pack, but backed off near the five-eighths pole, came back on midway through the turn, took command at the furlong pole, and drew clear. JOE PHILLIPS vied for the early lead three-wide while being confidently ridden, took a slight lead at the top of the stretch, had no answer for the late charge of the winner past the furlong marker, but kept on to save the place. DAVID'S GEM started sharply and was inside of a three-way early pace duel, battled on gamely through the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. ORB OF THE BORO was devoid of early speed and last early, finished with some late interest, and gained some ground in the final furlong. STAR SHOPPING contested the early pace from between horses, dropped out at the three-eighths pole, and chased the rest of the way from the rear.

CHASING COLTON pushed early to get forward position, stalked the early leader two-wide into the far turn, backed off going into the turn, dropped down to the inside, hugged the rail into the stretch, assumed command when the leader floated wide on the last bend, and drew away in the late stages. QUARANTINO was left alone to dictate the early fractions, widened the margin through the far turn, then floated out a bit wide on the last turn, leaving the rail open, yielded the lead in upper stretch, but kept on to hold second. ACTION MAN raced four-wide with the tracking group through the first half-mile, moved up to challenge for the lead leaving the seven-sixteenths pole, still four-wide, was in range of the leader three-wide at the top of the stretch, but had trouble changing leads, and hung in the late stages. COOL LESTER SMOOTH tracked in mid-pack with the second flight, and lacked a late bid; was pulled up on the clubhouse turn after the finish, vetted, and transported from the track in the equine ambulance. BECK'S SPIRIT raced at the back of the field and never managed to threaten. GREEWHIZ race three wide near the back and failed to rally.

STAR ELLA raced well off the pace through the first half-mile, started to run on with three furlongs to go, bid four-wide into the stretch, and finished best to gain the winning advantage in the final yards. FAIR TRADE hustled to an early lead, slowed down the pace, maintained a slight advantage to the far turn, then quickened late with something left in reserve, but could not hold the winner in the final yards. PEARL MAGIC veered out at the start, but was close up three-wide on the far turn, came under a stiff drive late on the far turn, and kept on well enough to hold third. MARMARA tracked in third position behind the early leaders to the far turn, then moved up to challenge midway through that turn, loomed to big threat approaching the quarter-pole, but was outfinished in the stretch. KATE WINS was outrun and far back throughout.

MANDALAY SKY raced close up on the inside, waited behind horses through the turn, tipped out to the two-path at the three-sixteenths marker, wore down a stubborn RAVISHING RUBY on the lead in deep stretch, and drove clear in the final yards. RAVISHING RUBY restless in the gate before the start, sprinted clear early after the break, jumped a shadow at the five-furlong marker, maintained a clear lead through the turn, and finished up well, and gave way grudgingly to the winner in the final yards. DOLLAR DANCE pressed the pace three-deep while under a drive, was not doing enough in the stretch to menace, but managed to hold on to claim the third prize. EXPONENTIALLY settled off the pace, made a middle move to gain contention, bid five wide into the stretch, but flattened out. SPECTACULAR TANGO tracked four-wide up close, moved up in range of the leaders passing the quarter pole, but was unable to sustain a bid through the stretch. PYRAMID SCHEME was slow to begin, dropped far back early, and passed tired rivals in the stretch. JUSTWORTHASHOT dropped back after a level start, chased from well off the pace, then a little to offer in the stretch. NATIVE LUCCI broke awkwardly raced near the back of the field and never threatened.

KETTLE COALMINE showed good speed from the break and seized the early lead, was left alone to dictate very slow fractions, held sway down the backstretch and through the turn, dug in under threat and had something left for the stretch, held on gamely to deep stretch, ducked out sharply at the 16th pole and just held safe to the finish. PARTY BOY broke off-balance but managed to be forwardly placed five or six-wide down the backstretch, moved up in range on the far turn, bid four-wide into the stretch, and closed gamely to just miss. EL CANELO ONE lost the path at the start, tracked the pace from between horses through the first half, made a run at the leader approaching the three-furlong pole, battled between horses into the stretch, took up sharply t he 16th pole and lost all chance. CRICKLEWOOD got a rail trip close up for the first-half mile, came under a ride on the far turn, stuck around as a threat to deep stretch but was outfinished and just missed hitting the board. H F S MEMORIES got forward position along the rail on the first turn, steadily dropped back to last on the backstretch, then tried to rally leaving the three-furlong pole, came six wide into the stretch, and managed to pass a few tired rivals. BUMPER STICKER was impeded and took up after the start to spot the rest a head start, settled at the back, then advanced up the rail late on the backstretch but could not sustain a bid in the stretch and tired. RED OHIO BRED ducked out sharply at the start, took back, then angled towards the inside going into the first turn, raced in in the two in the back half of the strung-out field to the far turn, then weakened, and had nothing to offer in the stretch. SILVER B B was bothered by the actions of the rivals in the two adjacent stalls, floated out after the start, then got caught six-wide in the first turn, continued to race in mid-pack wide down the backstretch, started to weaken leaving the three-furlong pole and had nothing left for the stretch run. INDY'S HOPE veered out at the start, raced near the back of the pack in the early stages, then was done before reaching the half-mile pole, and was eased up through the stretch to the finish line and walked off. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY POSTED FOR THE INCIDENT AT THE SIXTEENTH POLE. ALSO, THE JOCKEY ON #5 EL CANELO ONE LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE WINNER, #2 KETTLE COALMINE, ALLEGING INTERFERENCE AT THE SIXTEENTH POLE. AFTER THE REVIEW, THE OBJECTION WAS UPHELD. #2 KETTLE COALMINE WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM THE WIN AND PLACED THIRD.

LEGAL JARGON tracked close up five-wide, moved up to challenge for the lead approaching the three-furlong pole, battled with DRAGON HUNTER to mid-stretch, and pulled away in the final furlong. DRAGON HUNTER jumped out to the early lead, was joined past the five-furlong pole by JACE, briefly dueled inside of that one into the turn, then had to deal with LEGAL JARGON from the three-furlong pole, battled gamely on the inside through the stretch, then gave way grudgingly with about a furlong left to run. CINDY'S LAST SONG broke well and raced between horses in the middle of the pack on the backstretch, came four-wide into the stretch, altered course at the top of the stretch towards the inside, and finished well despite lugging in through the stretch run to gain the third spot. MARKAWAY broke in and bumped hard with SHALLOWBROOK, pulled to the front after the start despite restraint from the rider, backed off after passing the half, then came back on late on the turn and finished with some interest while never being a serious threat. SHALLOWBROOK got bumped hard by MARKAWAY at the start and was last down the backstretch, advanced four to five wide through the turn, continued into the stretch, and flattened out. BOAZ raced four to seven wide throughout and lacked a finish. RIVERS OF WEALTH broke well, but backed up through the field after the start, raced in mid-pack three-wide between rivals, dropped out past the three-furlong pole, and had little to offer in the stretch. JACE broke awkwardly to the inside after the start to be last away, rushed up to join the leader at the nine-sixteenths marker, dueled into the turn, then started a steady retreat leaving the three-furlong pole, and slowed to a walk in the stretch.
