FEELTHEBEAT prompted the pace into the turn, closed the gap on the winner on the bend, was repelled at the head of the lane and kept-on willingly to be gaining late on the tiring winner. NOBLE GASTON chased the runaway top pair throughout, failed to close ground on those two and went evenly as best of the rest. UNCLEJACKOMO trailed to upper stretch and was never a threat. ROSCO P. COLTRANE was one-paced and faded to the rear coming home.

NOTORIOUS SIXOHTWO pressed the pace from the inside to the top of the lane, responded when called upon to take a brief lead, was no match for the winner and kept-on willingly as second best in a good effort. ZIPPIN GIGI broke alertly to take command from the gate, set a pressured to the head of the stretch from three wide and weakened through the lane. POKER PARTNER went evenly failing to menace. LIMIT UP hustled to gain a stalking position down the backside, was set to an early drive to loom nearing the quarter pole and flattened out in upper stretch.

SPECIAL COLLETTE broke alertly to take the lead away from the gate, opened a well measured lead under mild pressure, widened the advantage when called upon turning for home to repel the bid of the runner-up, wandered about in the stretch and tired late to just hold on. CATTY REMARK tracked the pacesetter into the turn, rallied five wide to loom turning for home, was repelled by the winner in upper stretch and kept-on willingly to be gaining in deep stretch. BIONIC SAINT stalked the pace from between rivals on the turn and continued to chase down the lane with a grinding advance. SHEMITEBEAPORCHE raced mid-pack throughout showing some mild late interest without impact. DRILL BLITZ well placed prompting the early pace down the backside, lacked a response when called upon nearing the quarter pole and finished evenly. MYSTICAL MOBIL crowded at the start when outside rival broke inward to drop to the rear of the field and was never a threat from there. MOON DREAMS was not a factor.

SAGE RUNNER stalked the pace from four wide into the turn, rallied to engage the leader in upper stretch, was carried out by that one in the lane and closed well to draw off in the final sixteenth. UNCLE'S THE BANKER set a pressured early pace, repelled the presser to open a clear lead at the quarter pole, drifted out in upper stretch coming together with the winner and kept-on willingly as second best while having no answer for the winner down the lane. LT'S JACKNTHEBOX broke a step slow to be the distant trailer and made a late gain in the stretch to be up for the show. BANG A RANG chased the pacesetters through the turn in an early drive and rallied with mild late interest while never posing a threat. POP THE CORK pressed the pace to midway on the turn and tired through the lane.
