INDY'S HOPE reserved off the pace down the backside, rallied four wide with a steady advance on the turn and kept-on willingly to gain the place. MISTER ZAZU prompted the early pace, angled out leaving the half mile pole to circle the pacesetter, brushed with the winner nearing the three-eighths pole as that one angled in a path, mounted a bid on the bend, was unable to match strides with the winner turning for home and finished evenly to be best of the rest. HE IS DYNAMIC raced near the rear of the field while called upon leaving the half mile pole, continued under a drive throughout and finished with a grinding rally to hit the board under persistent handling. HIDDEN HEART showed early speed to be the leader on the backside and faded on the turn. DUDE THE LEGEND trailed most of the way posing no threat. BLUE BLOOD COWBOY was not a factor.
