DR. JOBO'S DAY hustled to the lead from the inside leaving the chute, dueled on the pace to the turn, edged clear on the bend, kicked clear when called upon turning for home and drew away while being kept to task in the lane. MY BABY BULLET pressed the pace to midway on the turn, could not go with the winner and finished willingly as second best. FORMYBOYS stalked the pace to the turn, failed to gain when called upon at the five-sixteenths pole, drifted out through the lane and finished evenly. NATIONAL PUNCHLINE slow early to be the trailer, rallied steadily on the turn, was carried out through the lane by FORMYBOYS and angled in off heels late in the lane without impact. SKUNK APE was one-paced never posing a threat. THE RIDER OF NATIONAL PUNCHLINE CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST FORMYBOYS FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE LANE, UPON REVIEW THE STEWARDS MADE NO CHANGE.

MAGICAL MONARCH set a pressured pace throughout, dug-in gamely from three wide down the lane to battle the length of the lane and prevailed in the final strides in a determined effort. THRU THE VINE raced up the fence leaving the first turn to press the pace down the backside, continued to press to the head of the lane, cut the corner to duel through the lane from the rail to draw even in the final fifty yards and was out-nodded at the wire. ATKINS unhurried for the first half mile to be the trailer, rallied on the turn five wide to be prominent turning for home and steadily inched closer down the lane coming up just short at the line in a good try. DR JACK FLYER stalked the pace to the far turn to be well placed and weakened midway on the bend. ONE TEN tracked the pace down the backside, rallied on the turn to loom and flattened out in upper stretch unable to sustain the rally.

HOLY SAINT sent to the lead from the rail to set a pressured pace throughout, responded to the winner's challenge turning for home, held the lead to the final strides and was just out-headed in a game effort. BEACH FRONT tracked the pacesetters to the quarter pole from the inside, cut the corner to loom boldly in upper stretch and finished evenly unable to sustain the bid. TAPSOLUTION stalked the pace to midway on the bend, rallied six wide to prominence at the head of the lane and flattened out in the stretch. SOUTHERN SENSE trailed never posing a threat.
