BLAZING ZENNA roused between horses to take a clear lead near the half mile marker but was headed midway through the turn and collared past the quarter pole while fighting on, shifted out to the two path near the eighth pole but was no match for the winner and was outfinished. PATTY'S HAVING FUN vied for the early lead from the three path then dropped back and trailed to midway through the turn, passed a tired one but was not a factor. IRON PYRITE was hustled along to the front while saving ground but was overtaken quickly and chased leaders to the turn before giving way.
