OLLIE'S FOLLY pressed the pace from the two path down the backstretch then moved up to engage the leader on the turn and took the lead near the quarter pole and drew clear. NAMBITI stalked the pace from the two path to the top of the stretch then shifted out to go in the three path near the eighth pole for the late run but couldn't catch the leader and was second best. ILIKETHAT raced off the pace while saving ground to the top of the stretch then shifted to the two path going into the stretch but fell back slightly before showing late interest to be a clear third. ORVILLE B hopped slightly leaving the gate then was forwardly placed from the three path through the turn then tipped out to the four path going into the stretch to make a belated bid but faltered. SWEET LEMON DROP tracked the leaders from the three path around the turn, tipped out to the four path going into the stretch but had no late kick and was not a factor. STONE COLD CAT trailed the field while racing in the four path around the turn then tipped out to the six path going into the stretch and passed a tired one. POWERFUL PHIL went to the front to set the pace with a clear lead down the backstretch then was challenged around the turn before being over taken near the quarter pole and slowly faded.

FRACTURE moved between horses early to press the pace from the three path to midway through the turn then drove past the leader while matching strides inside SOMETIME to the wire in a game effort but was outkicked. LET'S GO LIAM trailed the field while racing in the five path to the turn, continued on to make a rally while still racing wide but was no match for the top two and was a clear third. GO JACK GO went to the front to a pressured lead to midway through the turn then fought gamely to the top of the stretch before tiring. GAME PERFORMER chased the leaders from near the back down the backstretch then moved up slightly from the two path on the turn but was not a threat. POLIZON pressed the pace from the inside for the first furlong then faded through the turn and was outrun.

DREAMWIFEDREAMLIFE raced in the middle of the pack while saving ground down the backstretch then fell back on the final turn but made a belated rail bid to be a clear third. LADY MIDSHIPMAN was reluctant to load, bumped with rival leaving the gate, raced in the middle of the pack around the first turn then moved up from the four path down the backstretch but fell back on the final turn, shifted out to the five path near the eighth pole to show a late interest and improved her position. PRINCESS AZARA went to the front to set the pace with a clear lead before being overtaken near the quarter pole and gave way.
