QUIET AMIGO hustled from the break to take the early lead, got some pressure from SPIN DOCTOR leaving the half, dueled that rival through the turn, always keeping that one at bay, then responded to strong handling and urging in the stretch and went clear in the final furlong. SPIN DOCTOR took a light bump from the inside rival at the start, then moved up to press QUIET AMIGO on the lead near the half-mile pole, was never able to get a head in front at any point, but kept trying to mid-stretch, then weakened a bit in the final stages. CHIEF BUCKEYE tracked two-deep well off the pace, came three-wide into the stretch, and finished with mild interest. HENRY THE CAT was close up to the half, lost ground early on the turn, then chased the leading pair under a drive to the stretch and was outfinished for third. RUN ROCKY broke in and bumped lightly with STEAKY at the start, showed no speed from the start, dropped far back early, bid five-wide into the stretch but was unable to threaten. STREAKY mutually bumped with RUN ROCKY after the break, chased along the rail while being coaxed along early, started to lose ground early on the turn, and had nothing to offer in the stretch.
