BOURBON N BLUSH got away well, made the lead racing off the rail going well in hand, opened up on the turn, then widened in the stretch, drifting out slightly late under a hand ride. KIDDIE COCKTAIL was off a step slowly, raced up close early, came under a ride midway through the turn, and was no match for the winner in the late stages, but kept to task late to win the race for second. GRIMES GLEN broke slowly, then lost the path at the start, chased four-wide down the backstretch, had aim on the leader approaching the quarter pole, but flattened out in the stretch. POWER VISION stumbled at the break, then broke awkwardly to the outside into the path of GRIMES GLEN, then hustled up to race near the leaders to the turn, lost ground under a ride, and was not doing enough late. HOT DISPUTE was always two to three wide off the pace and lacked a rally. LIL SHARPIE lost footing exiting the gate, spotted the field a head start and trailed throughout.
