COLOR BEARER opted to race in the middle of the pack four wide, moved up through the turn to enter the stretch in a competitive position, overtook rivals in the final furlong and just lasted. RED CHIPS bumped at the start, was off the pace on the inside during the early stages, gained position through the turn to make a five wide bid entering the stretch, rallied but came up just short. RADIO SILENT showed good early speed, drifted out a couple paths in the stretch and weakened. SILENT DRILL stalked the pace from along the inside, dueled rivals in the upper parts of the stretch but faded soon after. TAHLEQUAH JOE tracked the pace three wide, weakened in the final furlong. CARSON N SPENCE reluctant to load the gate, hopped and broke outwardly, trailed for most, passed retreating foe. ORVILLE B bumped at the start and slightly bobbled, raced off the pace, eased across.
