RENEWED was allowed to settle from the break, then took up a stalking position just behind KELLEY JEAN down the backstretch, assumed command passing the three-furlong pole, went clear of the rest while being confidently ridden, then held sway through the stretch geared down in the last sixteenth. COLLECT GOLD broke well but was unable to keep up with the early pace initially, made a forward move heading into the turn, then moved up into second position leaving the quarter pole, chased RENEWED gamely through the stretch but was unable to close the gap and finished well clear of the next horse. RIVERS RUN RED bore in after the start and was at the back early, found best stride leaving the half-mile pole and moved up under a ride through the turn, lugged in through the stretch, but was able to gain third but still far behind the top two. DIANNA'S LADY broke in a tangle and was slow to begin, lacked any early speed, and was last into the turn, then passed tired rivals in the stretch. HOLIDAY MUSICAL chased in third position to the turn, then slowed to a walk in the stretch. DOLLAR DANCE stumbled at the break, then was pinballed in the first strides, was under a ride early to maintain contact with the field, but struggled to keep up on after the turn and offered little in the stretch run. KELLEY JEAN broke sharply and sprinted clear early, then gave way readily approaching the three-furlong pole and stopped.
