Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

DRILLS WILD BRAT was forced out a bit at the stretch, pressed the early pace to the outside of BELLE BOTTOMS, pulled even near the quarter pole, dueled that rival through the stretch, got a head in front near the wire, and prevailed. BELLE BOTTOMS broke out at the start while being hustled to the front, made the front under pressure from DRILLS WILD BRAT, dueled that rival late on the turn and into the stretch, battled gamely but was outkicked in the final yards. KICHI KITSU broke well, settled close up off the pace, saved ground through the turn, then tipped out three-wide for the stretch run and finished well but could not get to the top two. BANANA PUDDING broke in and bumped MIDNIGHT WARRIOR, was outpaced initially, then advanced closer through the turn, finished with some interest under strong handling, but could not make up the needed ground. A KISS FOR KHOZAN shied from the inside rival at the start, then took a bump from BANANA PUDDING, was four-wide contesting the early pace, bid five-wide into the stretch, had some trouble changing leads, but was mildly gaining in the late stages. NOT TODAY pressed the early pace three-wide, was unable to kick on from the quarter pole, and finished evenly in the stretch. ZIP CODE ENVY chased the front pack to the turn, then launched a four-to-five wide bid on the turn, but was outfinished. MIDNIGHT WONDER lost the path and took up after the start, regained contact with the field on the turn, bid five-wide under a drive into the stretch but was unable to threaten. MO CO GOLD stumbled at the start, settled near the back and lacked a rally. COMIDA comidA showed speed to race close up to the turn, then was outrun the rest of the way.
