MEXITEXAFORNIA broke on top but ceded the lead to PRACTICAL MAN, remained in a stalking position while always traveling well, responded when asked to go on passing the three-furlong pole, took command in upper stretch, and drew away under steady handling to win clear. MR LAOBAN settled mid-pack between horses, launched a bid from the three-furlong pole, slipped through an opening along the rail into the stretch, surged late, and finished on even terms with a rival for the place. GILLIGAN broke out and mutually bumped with the outside rival, raced close up three-wide just off the early pace, came four-wide into the stretch and closed well. PRACTICAL MAN veered out at the start, then hustled up to take the early lead, was under pressure from MEXITEXAFORNIA through the early stages, could not kick on with that rival in upper stretch, weakened in the final furlong, and missed out on the minor award. SOUTHERN SENSE broke in and bumped with GILLIGAN at the start, was five-wide throughout and lacked a raily. SILVER STYLE slow early, moved up the rail to race in mid-pack by the turn, then, was unable to keep pace and outrun through the late stages. LITTLE VAQUERO broke alertly and made the lead without really being asked, opened up a clear lead on the turn, then held sway down the stretch under steady handling. HE'S IN CHARGE raced in the middle of the compact field through the early stages, bided time behind horses through the turn, then launched a bid up the rail when clear past the quarter pole, finished up well, but could not close the gap on the winner. REINVEST was a little slow into stride, moved to the outside of the pack for the run down the backstretch, then was three-wide through the turn, swung out six-wide into the stretch, and put in a strong finish to gain third. BIG BUCKSALOT lunged, then veered outward at the start, chased four-to-five wide, and was mildly gaining ground late. TRIKITRAKI broke well, then raced close up three-wide in the initial stages, went evenly late, and lacked a finish. EL ROSILLO broke well to be in the early pace mix, came under a ride midway through the turn, and was outfinished in the late stages. OVERBORE broke a step slow, and trailed throughout.
