ROMANIAN PRINCE contested the early pace from between horses, then dueled with FOURDATESFORHOCO into the stretch, gained the advantage on that one by mid-stretch, and went clear in the final yards. FOURDATESFORHOCO broke on top but veered out sharply at the start into the path of TEMPERED DREAM, vied three-wide on the early pace to the stretch, dueled with ROMANIAN PRICE through the stretch, exchanging a couple of bumps along the way, then came up a bit short in the late stages. TEMPERED DREAM was impeded by FOURDATESFORHOCO at the start, launched a bid with three furlongs to run, produced a steady finish through the stretch, but could not get close to the top pair. SILENT DRILL settled inside at the rear, not far from the leaders, was boxed in through the turn to mid-stretch, then was unable to quicken when clear and finished evenly. SADIE'S SILVER KID vied inside a pair of rivals to the stretch, then gave way. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE START, AFTER A BRIEF REVIEW, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN. THE JOCKEY ON #2 FOURDATESFORHOCO LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST #2 ROMANIAN PRINCE ALLEGING INTERFERENCE AT THE TOP OF THE STRETCH. SPIRIT OF AKRON stalked the early pace from the rail, was behind horses approaching the stretch, then split foes near the three-sixteenths, hit the front in upper stretch, and held clear to the wire racing on the left lead. RAISE THE PURSES hustled from the start and was four-wide in the early pace battle, poked a head in front at the five-sixteenths marker, was overtaken by SPIRIT OF AKRON at the top of the stretch, but help on well to save the place. RUMBLE STRIP RON brushed with the inside rival after the break, raced just behind the early pace battle into the turn, then topped out five wide to bid for the lead at the top of the stretch, finished up well under steady handling, but could not get to the top pair while finishing well clear of the rest of the field. EL MARRO stumbled at the start, recovered quickly to join the early pace mix, dropped back approaching the three-furlong pole, and was stuck behind horses nearing the quarter pole. was put to strong handling and urging through the stretch but came up short of a minor award. chased the main pack to the turn, made a mild bid approaching the quarter pole, went about six-wide into the stretch but was outfinished. SHANGHAI PRINCE was hustled up after the start, had a slight lead with several in close pursuit, yielded the lead at the top of the stretch, and tired. MOR CRAFTY lost the path shortly after the start, trailed throughout.

SOUP TODAY took a bump at the start, stalked the pace from the inside, then took over the lead midway through the turn, dueled with ROGUES A PLOTTING through the stretch, and kept a clear advantage over that one while racing greenly. ROGUES A PLOTTING ducked in at the start into SOUP TODAY, made the lead under some pressure from DR SPIRITO with several others in close pursuit, surrendered the lead to the first rival in upper stretch, battled on, though a bit green, but could not close the gap. DREAM BOY lugged in at the start, bothering the inside rival, settled four-to-five wide at the rear of the main group, lugged in through the stretch run, but managed to improve and move up into third. RIVERS OF WEALTH settled in the middle of the main pack, ran on some in the stretch, but failed to change leads. LUCKY COUGAR broke inward making contact with MO CO GOLD at the start, moved up along the inside to press the pace, then took up just past the seven-sixteenths marker as the loose horse attempted to squeeze through along the rail, took advantage of an opening along the inside as the rest stetered clear of the outlaw, gained a short lead in upper stretch then held off a game LARIMAR in a spirited stretch battle to prevail. LARIMAR broke well, made the early lead, angled over to the inside and was under some pressure from LUCKY COUGAR on the outside, had to check approaching the quarter pole when the loose horse crossed the path, lost some momentum, and allowed two rivals to gain an advantage into the stretch, came back on to battle LUCKY COUGAR to the wire, but came up short while well clear of the next finisher. SOCIALBUTTERFLYTAM raced four-wide down the backstretch, always close up to the pace, was clear of the loose horse but floated out a path or two on the turn as the rest cleared a path for the loose horse, dropped back down to the rail for the stretch run, and finished up well to gain the third prize but well behind the top pair. MO CO GOLD got squeezed at the start, then settled between horses in the tracking group, steadied early on the turn as the others tried to avoid the loose horse, dropped down to the rail and ran on some under a strong hand ride. HARTFUL HOPE settled at the back of the compact field, steadied to avoid the loose horse at the half-mile pole, kept to the inside into the stretch but was unable to improve. COMIDA COMIDA pressed the early pace to the turn, was poised to make a bid for the lead approaching the quarter pole, but did not respond to the urgings of the rider and was unable to threaten in the lane. WATERWORKS reared at the start and left the stall without a rider, moved up through the field, causing some chaos in the field, went wide on the turn, then was caught by the outrider in the stretch on the far outside as the race was still ongoing, and walked off. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE START. AFTER A REVIEW NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

CARMEL ROSE lugged in after the start, moved up to join BIONDETTISNITEMARE on the inside, dueled that rival into the stretch, then staged a heady duel through the lane, got a head in front in deep stretch, and held to the finish. BIONDETTISNITEMARE broke best and went to the front, confronted early by CARMEL ROSE up the inside, held sway through the turn, responded when set down at the top of the stretch, battled gamely to the wire but came up short. COMPUTE THIS settled just behind the pace, launched a bid leaving the three-furlong pole, drifted a bit wide on the last bend, then was unable to narrow that gap on the top two in the late stages. ILLUMINATE raced close up five-wide down the backstretch, came under a ride from the three-furlong pole, cut the corner to the inside into the stretch and was making up some ground in the final furlong. MIDNIGHT GODDESS raced in mid-pack, then faltered in the stretch. MYSTICAL MOBIL outrun early, passed tired foes. QUEEN KITTY hustled up after a slow start to join the early pace mix, lost the path and steadied near the half-mile pole, lost momentum, and was unable to recover. MAMMA IN THE CLOUD dropped back after a level start, made a four-wide middle move on the turn, but flattened out in upper stretch and stopped.
