CAUSE OF LOVE was a little slow into stride, but moved up to join the early fray before the turn, saved ground tracking the two leaders into the stretch, then responded when set down, gained the lead inside the furlong marker, and drew clear in the final furlong. HELLO SWEETS took up in tight quarters after the start, settled behind the field to the turn, then started to rally from the seven-sixteenths marker, had to wait for racing room late on the turn, then got a nice opening in upper stretch, finished up strong, but could not get to the winner. CHLOES ANGEL settled mid-pack initially, then moved up into the main pack heading into the turn, was without a path much of the way, then bid four-wide into the stretch, had some trouble changing leads in upper stretch but got straightened out and moved up to gain the minor award. TALE OF THE LYON veered in at the start, but still made the lead in the initial stages with several pressing the issue, pulled away on the turn with BEAUTIFUL CHARADE the only other contender at that point, battled gamely to mid-stretch, then tired. BEAUTIFUL CHARADE broke well and contested the early pace from between horses, broke off from the rest to challenge for the lead approaching the quarter pole, then flattened out in the stretch. GRAY TORMENTOR came away a little sluggish, was having to be coaxed along into the first turn, settled inside with the forward group well behind the leaders, launched a bid with three furlongs to run, then came out to the two path to engage HE'S MY BOY into the stretch, pulled well clear of the rest, gained the advantage inside the sixteenths marker and won clear in the end. HE'S MY BOY came away well from the break and secured inside position on the clubhouse turn, rated behind HIDDEN HEART through the first half-mile, then bid for the lead leaving the three-furlong pole, hooked up with GRAY TORMENTOR at the top of the stretch, battled that foe gamely but yielded in the final yards. DEW IT WITH CLASS tracked the early pace three-wide, bid three-wide at the head of the stretch, was unable to go with the top pair but outfinished the rest to claim the third prize. HIDDEN HEART was sent hard from the start and gained the early lead on the first turn, opened up a couple of lengths down the backstretch, and was left alone to set the early pace, then was overtaken near the five-sixteenths marker and had little left for the stretch run. PLAYFULASITGETS raced at the front of the second flight to the half, was under a drive midway through the turn, and kept to task, but could not generate much of a threat in the late stages. WEEKEND RETREAT had no early speed despite the efforts of the rider, raced far back through the early stages then improved a few positions in the stretch. BLOED COWBOY tracked not far off the early leaders while under a hold, did not respond when asked to go on near the three-furlong pole. 

PICARO made the lead under pressure from CANAVERO, shook free of that one at the three-furlong pole, opened up a clear lead in the stretch but could not hold off the winner in the final yards, while finishing well clear of the next horse. COOL COUPLE was allowed to settle from the break, was at the back of the field heading into the turn, then produced a steady finish to move into a clear third. GREEWHIZ last away, moved up four-wide down the backstretch, was carried five or six wide into the stretch, and was mildly gaining. BREEZE THE BAYOU was outpaced early and never a factor. SPELLED WELL got put in-tight by IMPROBABLE FIRST in the initial stages, settled four-wide well off the pace, and lacked a rally. HEART OF AN ANGEL chased under a drive to the turn, then retreated. CANAVERO pressed the pace to the three-furlong pole, then tired. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE EARLY RUNNING. AFTER A REVIEW, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

SWEET UNIQUE hopped at the start and was last away, steadily advanced through the turn, then rallied five-wide down the stretch under steady handling to win clear. MIDNIGHT WONDER was hustled from the start, took the lead before the half-mile pole, opened up a bit through the turn, dug in under threat at the top of the stretch, and held off all but the winner. KICHI KITSU was pushed to get forward position from the start, settled inside just behind MIDNIGHT WONDER, was under a stiff drive from the three-furlong pole, gained a narrow lead in upper stretch, but could not finish the job and was outkicked in the final yards. NUBLADA veered out at the start and made contact with CHANEL SPIRIT, raced mid-pack, bid five-wide into the stretch, and finished with interest but was not doing enough. SHE'S CRAFTY was outpaced early, raced at the rear, kept to the inside, and improved a bit in the late stages. LIONISTIC had good speed from the start, tracked the pacesetter to the outside of KICHI KITSU through the turn, then flattened out in the stretch. CHANEL SPIRIT bobbled at the start, then took a bump at the start, dropped to the rear, went wide on the turn, but could not generate much of a rally in the stretch. OH GLORIOUS DAY moved up after a tardy start to press the early pace, backed off in traffic before the half-mile, pole, then shifted out a path for running room but did not respond when asked to go on and faltered in the stretch. KINDERHOOK settled in the middle of the field after an even beginning, ranged up three-wide near the quarter pole, had a little trouble keeping a straight course in mid-stretch, battled BOHEMIAN STYLE in the final yards, and got a favorable head bob at the line. BOHEMIAN STYLE reared at the start, nearly dislodging the rider, moved towards the inside down the backstretch and bided time while saving ground, was blocked briefly just past the three-sixteenths marker, but split horses inside the furlong grounds, dueled KINDERHOOK to the wire, and came up on the short end of the photo. SUNSET TOWN tracked in mid-pack along the rail, loomed three-wide near the quarter pole while under a stiff drive, angled out to the five-path in deep stretch and surged late but came up short. BLAZING BURROUGHS dueled outside of ZIPPIN GIGI through the early stages, then weakened in mid-stretch. ZIPPIN GIGI dueled inside of BLAZING BURROUGHS to the stretch, then gave way. LUST FOR LIFE was outpaced early, raced four-to-five wide, then lacked a meaningful finish. AIR SHOW under a ride from the outset, still dropped to last before the turn, kept to task late, but was unable to threaten. PLAYING FOR KEEPS broke well and raced three-wide in the early pace mix, dropped back under a ride before the three-furlong pole, then was unable to threaten in the stretch. COASTERTOTHEMOON was briefly close up, then steadily retreated, came back on a bit late, but was unable to threaten.
