VALID CONNECTION settled inside with the tracking group, ever far back, bid three-wide for the lead at the quarter pole, gained the advantage in upper stretch, then went clear under steady handling and intermittent urging. CHARLIESLITLEDEVIL was lapped on STAROFTHEGAME from the outset, ramped up the pressure on that one near the three-furlong mark, dueled into the stretch, got the best of the rival by mid-stretch, but could not go with the winner late. STAROFTHEGAME secured the rail position and the lead into the first turn, slowed the pace way down while getting moderate pressure from a pair of rivals to the outside, quickened with CHARLIESLITLEDEVIL approaching the three-furlong pole, but could not produce the needed response in the final furlong. INTERVAL took up going into the first turn near the seven-eighths pole, settled between horses in the second flight, then dropped to last before the far turn, came back on five-wide into the stretch, and finished with some interest while lugging in. WITH FULL HONORS got caught four-wide on the first turn, started a forward move when asked to go on from the seven-sixteenths maker, came four-wide into the stretch but could not sustain the bid and flattened out. DAYTONA GOLD raced three-wide into the first turn, then stalked the early pace down the backstretch, started a steady retreat after passing the three-furlong pole and had little to offer in the stretch. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT GOING INTO THE FIRST TURN. AFTER A REVIEW, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

VESPERA broke on top but was unable to contest the early lead despite coaxing from the rider, came under a full-out drive midway through the turn, responded, and took a short lead in upper stretch, and held sway under steady handling. AURORA'S MUSIC was initially three-wide with the second flight, made a forward move after passing the half-mile pole, loomed three-wide near the quarter pole, kept on gamely in the middle of the track, but was outfinished by the winner in the final yards. KHALI J rushed up to join NOT TODAY on the lead after a bit of a tardy start, dueled into the turn, responded when set down in upper stretch, but was outfinished in the late stages. LITTLE MISS MUNNY settled mid-pack early, was moving up towards the leaders when forced to steady slightly just past the half-mile pole, lost some position but came back under steady handling to improve a bit. NOT TODAY went quickly to the front, moved out to the two path, got some early pressure from KHALI J, then an additional threat from AURORA'S MUSIC late on the turn, and weakened in mid-stretch. VOTARY dropped far behind early and was never a threat. SACOS STOGIE raced up close three-wide to the turn, then was outrun from the three-furlong pole. SHE'S SO SEXY chased close up through the early stages, then drifted out about six or seven wide on the last bend and faltered in the stretch.

DARK VADER steadied after the break, then went to the outside of the field and moved up four-to-five wide, circled the field on the turn to bid six-wide for the lead at the top of the stretch, had a little trouble getting on the correct lead in upper stretch, but finished up well, and collared the leaders in sight of the finish line. THE PINK Z was quick to the front, led a host of pursuers to the stretch, battled gamely to the wire, and outfinished all but the winner. WETZEL was a little slow to get going but steadily advanced down the backstretch, kept to the inside and was up with the leaders with three furlongs to run, battled gamely down the stretch while racing on the wrong lead, but came up short in the end. ELLIOT THE DRAGON hustled from the break to press the early pace three-wide, loomed three-wide at the top of the stretch while under a full-out drive but was outkicked in the final furlong. GAPPER was last away then raced near the back of the compact field, had every chance in the stretch but weakened. OLLIE'S FOLLY was a bit slow to begin, raced mid-pack early, then loomed a threat approaching the stretch, came five-wide out of the turn, and did not produce a rally. HITE was close up for a furlong while racing wide down the backstretch, lost ground through the turn while under a drive, and was not involved in the late stages.

LAST MINUTE MIKEY was a little slow into stride, steadied twice in traffic before the half, dropped to last, then went around the field on the turn, swung five or six wide into the lane, continued to rally past rivals while lugging in through the stretch, and was along in time. TRUTH N SOUL broke outward at the start, then was sent to the lead, took the field through the turn under mild pressure from the outside, fought back when challenged at the quarter pole, repelled those foes in deep stretch, then was unable to hold off the winner. JACOBI ducked in at the start and slammed into DUO, moved up four wide to gain contention heading into the turn, was the outside of three horses vying for the lead turning for home, then lugged in through the stretch and faltered in the final yards. DUO got sandwiched by the rivals on both sides at the start, stumbled, nearly losing the rider, recovered, and moved up to track just behind the pacesetters to the turn, bid four-wide at the top of the stretch but failed to change leads and could not find the needed late kick in the final stages. BUCKEYE MIKE broke outward a bit awkwardly but still managed to be in the early pace mix, pressed TRUTH N SOUL into the turn, then made a try for the lead approaching the quarter pole, was unable to find another gear when needed, and was outfinished in the final stages. HEIDI N SEEK broke out at the start, then was allowed to settle, advanced under a ride through the turn, but weakened in upper stretch and was unable to produce a finishing kick. BE AN EDDIE was pushed to get forward position from the start, was in tight near the half, then dropped off the pace on the turn and outrun through the stretch. HE IS DYNAMIC came away well, then was under a ride to keep pace, steadied sharply near the seven-sixteenths marker, lost all forward momentum, then steadied slightly approaching the three-furlong pole and was unable to recover. MOONSHINE JOE pressed the pace three-wide after an erratic start, weakened late on the turn, then had nothing to offer in the stretch. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE RUN DOWN THE BACKSTRETCH. AFTER A REVIEW, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN. THE RIDER ON #4 BUCKEYE MIKE LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST #8 JACOBI, ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN DEEP STRETCH. PROFESSOR NICK got a clean break, chased the pace battle while under a steady ride, went through an opening at the head of the lane, and finished up well under steady handling to hold clear of a mild late challenge in the final yards. MOBIL MISSION lacked early speed and dropped far behind early, started to run on from midway through the turn, then went about seven-wide into the stretch but put in a good rally down the lane, came up short for the win but was well clear of the next finisher. SILVER IS A GIFT broke outward and brushed with MOBIL MISSION at the start, came under a ride to move up from the back, produced a grinding finish in the late stages, and outfinished the rest of the field to take the minor award. GRITS N GRAVY hustled up after a slow start, was briefly in the lead, then backed off the developing pace battle, saved ground to the stretch, finished with some interest, but could not generate a winning late kick. DRILL EM broke in and made light contact with COUPLE BEERS DEEP, then was away awkwardly, was hard ridden to get into contention, started to make some headway on the turn, then swung six-wide into the stretch and finished evenly. BUMPKIN had good speed from the start, vied between horses to the half, then went clear of the rest with only PLUF TUFF keeping up, came into the stretch with a clear lead, but weakened in mid-stretch and was outfinished. P J'S BOY settled mid-pack, moved up late on the turn to loom a threat, but could not sustain the effort and faltered. PLUM TUFF broke well and contested the early pace four-wide, bid for the lead passing the quarter pole, then stopped to a gallop by mid-stretch. MOMENT IN THE DARK broke alertly but came away from the gate awkwardly, struggled to keep pace, and was not involved in the late stages. COUPLE BEERS DEEP took a light bump from DRILL EM at the start, was otherwise away well and pressed the early pace from between horses, dropped out at the three-furlong mark, and had nothing left for the stretch run.
