HESS close up in the second flight while between horses, in traffic through the second bend, waited for room turning for home, split foes upper stretch, came in still looking for some clear room past the furlong marker closing a hole up partially but not completely for AARON who checked up, continued toward the inside and challenged the leader late, narrowly gained the nod at the wire. BIG DRINKER angled in when back off the pace to save a little ground early in the first turn, tracked the leaders from the outside up the backstretch, advanced on the outside and challenged four wide into the stretch, lugged in a bit when putting a head in front with a furlong to run, continued to lead until late to narrowly miss.
