SULWE settled well off the soft pace in the early going while saving ground through the first turn, two path into the far bend, swung out four wide to hit a moving seam turning for home, reached the leader past the furlong marker well out in the strip and edged clear late under steady handling. LADY WOOPIG closest to the leader outside that one, advanced and engaged that rival in the far turn, put a head in front turning for home, offered brief resistance to the winner when that one came calling nearing midstretch then could not match strides, clearly second best. PRINCIPAL ANITA in the second flight inside, shifted out to be three wide for the drive, lodged a brief and mild bid with a furlong remaining between the top two, flattened out to finish up best of the rest. GOLD STRATEGY away in good order, showed the way through the first turn inside, set a soft set of early fractions, headed late in the final turn and steadily weakened. C. C. HARBOR off a step slow, saved ground through the turn, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while not a serious threat. SISTERSOUTTACHROME settled in the second flight while racing off the inside, had little left for the drive. SUMMORYA tired after racing three wide most of the way.

END OF INNOCENCE broke on top, showed the way up front early just off the inside, headed late backstretch, dueled through the turn along the inside, put a head back in front in upper stretch, drove clear while trying to drift out a bit. NO PAY NO HAY in the second flight early inside, continued to save ground turn, moved out for the drive, could not get to the winner the final furlong, well clear of the others. MY KINDA TROUBLE broke well, pressed the winner from the outside early, dueled through the turn in the two path, weakened gradually when headed by that same rival in upper stretch, also was not a match for the runner up, saved the show. THORN CROWN went one paced throughout while racing three to four wide. SPIN THE BREEZE lacked early foot along the rail, improved inside of rivals turning into the stretch, flattened out the final furlong. IFUAINFIRSTURLAST void of early foot, improved position off the inside without posing a serious threat. CRYSTAL SYMPHONY in mid pack outside, five wide into the turn, continued five wide into the stretch, went evenly

to the wire. SUNNYANDSEVENTY settled off the pace in the two path, came up empty for the stretch run. MISS ANALYZED broke back, failed to menace while racing in the two path. GEORGIA ON E'SMIND chased the dueling leaders for a half and gave way. BABE IN THE WOODS four wide through most of the turn, remained back. BE MY HUCKLEBERRY off slowly, lagged and trailed throughout to be always outrun.
