MIRI A COINCIDENCE broke alertly, narrowly set a pressured pace in the three path, larger lead into the lane, held the runner up safe late under firm handling. HOPPIN JOHN in the second flight while just off the inside, moved closer in the two path late turn, chased the winner the final furlong, not enough for that one late. BLAME J D back off the pace while racing outside, four wide through the turn when making a mild advance into the lane, not enough late for the place. CHOCTAW ZIP off a step slow, moved up outside, five wide through the turn, continued to improve position through the lane. I'M AN OAK pressed the pace while between horses, in the two path and inside the winner into the lane, weakened in the drive. BLESSED VISION void of speed, continued back while four wide far turn, came five wide for the drive, displayed some mild interest while not a serious threat. YOU VEE CEE broke back, lacked early foot while well wide into the turn, came six wide for the drive, improved in upper stretch then flattened out the final furlong to finish up evenly.

AMAZING SUCCESS in mid pack and three wide, lacked a closing response through the stretch. PEACE DOG remained back while racing three to four wide through the turn. REEF'S DESTINY back off the pace inside, moved around a tiring rival to be in the two path for the drive, lacked a closing response. COOLER KING prompted the issue up front along the inside, gave way late in the turn. ATTA PARTY in the second flight while four wide, gave way in the drive.

SPRINT OUT PASS off a step slow, raced back while moving outside, four to five wide into the lane, rallied down the middle part of the strip, collared the leader with a sixteenth to run and kicked clear. SIR GALLIVANT forwardly placed just off the inside, challenged outside the leader in the second turn, took over, clear into the stretch, continued to hold a daylight advantage with less than a furlong remaining, proved no match for the winner late, clearly second best. VINO VIDICI in mid pack while off the inside, came four wide into the stretch when beginning to advance, up in time for the show, no threat to the top two. SPEECHLESS bobbled start, four wide into the first turn, angled in a bit to race forwardly and three wide the middle half mile, lacked a closing punch. STONINGTON broke back, lacked speed, advanced in the two path through the final turn, continued to better position without posing a serious threat. MAGIC MOVER away in good order, cleared toward the inside, set the pace four just over six furlongs then faltered when headed by the runner up late in the final turn. AUDAX MINOR fell back to trail after the start, continued to lack speed up the backstretch, three to four wide into the stretch, passed tiring rivals while not a factor. CUTLASS KING in mid pack while racing off the inside, lacked a response in the drive. RACHAEL'S WAGON pushed in at the break, remained always back in lacking a closing response. FULL VICTORY broke in, was straightened to race forwardly along the inside four five furlongs

then began a steady retreat. PREDECESSOR was finished after a half.



RAYMOND lacked speed well wide, five to six wide turning for home, finished with good energy down the middle of the strip to win going away. TOP GUN TOMMY broke well, vied up front five wide up the backstretch and into the turn, four wide into the lane when taking over, clear a furlong out, could not contain the winner, held sway for the place. EL DIABLO ROJO last to leave, trailed early as a result, began to move three wide in the turn, finished willingly to be getting to the runnerup late. VALE pinched and steadied in tight quarters soon after the start, settled in the second flight three wide, came five wide out of the turn, closest with a furlong to run then went flat to the wire. DRILL'S LI'L MAN in mid pack while outside, five wide exiting the turn, improved a bit without proving a serious threat. IAN GLASS lacked speed, raced in the two path inside of several rivals out of the turn, lacked a serious closing kick. RUSSIAN TO WIN vied up front while four wide and between horses into the turn, two path entering the stretch, had little left in the run to the wire. SUMMER SPLASH also with the early pace while between horses, held a narrow advantage late in the turn then faltered through the stretch. LIGHTNING STRUCK restless in the gate prior to the start, broke with the field, with the pace between horses early, pinched, checked up into the turn, fell back and did

not recover. PRESSURE remained always back while racing toward the inside. HEY EUGENE fractious in the gate, broke with leaders, narrowly set the early pace, shuffled back along the rail into the turn, continued to fade and eventually jogged in.
