MAN IN THE CAN broke sharp, raced closest to the leader, advanced in the two path to draw even with that one midway on the final turn, showed the way into the lane, drew out upper stretch and continued to widen under a hand ride to win ridden out in a sharp effort. BLACK APPLE settled off the pace and the inside, advanced three wide final turn, chased the winner into and through the stretch, proved no match for that one, far clear of the others. READY SHOES lacked early foot inside, two to three path when called on for run late in the final turn, along for the show, not a threat to the top two. STRING THEORY boxed along the rail through the first turn when slow to settle, continued to save ground, came up empty for the drive. BETTYS CASH moved up along the inside to take command into the first turn, showed the way up the backstretch, offered little resistance when the winner took over late in the final turn, faded down the lane. DINNER AT CRUMPIES off a step slow, remained back while racing off the inside. AFLEET SKY fell back to trail, never a threat.

TOO TOO TWENTYTWO unhurried early outside, three to four wide through the turn, asked for some run into the stretch, collared the l3eader past the furlong marker, clear late, enough left to hold the runner up safe in the final strides. SAFE BET lacked early foot, four wide through the turn, roused, late run well out in the strip, finished willingly to narrowly miss. VINEY in mid pack off the inside, two path through the turn, displayed some late interest to also be going well at the end, clear of the others. LOW ON FUNDS void of speed, also raced just off the inside through the turn, began to advance out of the turn, continued to improve through the lane in also showing some late interest. STREAKIN DEACON forwardly placed out in the strip, three wide bid turn, took over into the stretch, clear upper stretch, could not last. SWEET DEVOTION broke back, void of speed inside, steered out for the drive, passed some tiring rivals while not a serious threat. RAZORBACK ARMY forwardly placed for a half in the two path, had little left for the stretch run. Z BOSS in the second flight early inside, continued to save ground turn when beginning to fade, continued that retreat through the stretch. BELLO broke sharp, set the early pace along the inside, faltered when headed turning for home. CZECHOSLOVAKIAN last away, trailed throughout to be always outrun.

ESKENFORARISE back off the pace while well wide up the backstretch, five wide into the turn, swept to the fore while remaining outside through the bend, showed the way into the stretch after angling in to the three path, kicked clear. PAYTON'S BEAUTY in the second flight early, traffic in the two path into the turn, came three wide after angling out a bit for the drive, rallied to be in time for the place, not a serious threat to the winner. COMMANDER DIXIE back off the pace while just inside the winner, moved with that one in the four path through the turn, took over with that same foe, flattened out a bit in the final sixteenth to be caught for the runner up spot. BLUE DAZZLER in the second group with the runner up outside that one, four to five wide turning for home, went evenly the final furlong while well out in the strip in lacking a late punch. FAB GIRL lacked early foot, three wide through the turn, improved position in the stretch without posing a serious threat. LET'SGOJLO with the pace along the inside up the backstretch, narrowly showed the way into the turn, began to weaken when headed by the winner late in the bend and continued to lost position down the lane. DINAHS GIRL with the pace while three wide and between rivals up the backstretch, fell back through the turn and failed to respond in the drive. FLAMING GLORY off slowly trailed for a half, four wide turn, passed some tiring rivals after the issue had been decided. DEVIL'S DEN contested the issue early while between foes, tired drive. LA DINAMITA bumped at the start, in the second flight along the inside when forced to steady in tight quarters along the rail, shuffled back and did not recover. ILLY SIMZ broke out, bumped foe at the start, remained always back in the two path.

LUNAR MODULE in the second flight closest to but not on the rail, dropped to the fence late in the turn, lodged a rail bid inside the leader nearing the furlong grounds, dueled to the wire, gained the nod at the wire to prove narrowly best. I'M WIDE AWAKE dueled up front in the two path and inside the other speed, put that rival away to briefly garner a larger lead in upper stretch, responded when the winner challenged along the inside soon after, raced on equal terms with that one to the wire, just missed. MISCHIEVOUS M in the second group while outside, four wide through the turn, crept a bit closer into the lane, roused, could not get to that pair late while prevailing for the show. PINELAND settled pace off the pace, continued to lack speed early turn, four wide for the drive, not enough late for the the show while widest of the lead groups. RUN JALEN RUN in the second group while three wide and between horses for a half, came up empty for the stretch. MANTA REY fell back to trail after the start, passed tiring rivals without making a major impact four wide. BOURBON'S FAULT off a step slow, remained back in failing to menace while three wide in the turn. SHACKLEFORD STRONG in mid pack while racing toward the inside, tired from those early efforts. G T FIVE HUNDRED dueled up front outside the runner up, first to blink after a half. TRUST DADDY off a step slow, was never a factor.
