BIG TECH broke inward but on top, dueled up front off the inside, disposed of the other speed by midway on the turn, repelled a second foe in upper stretch and then drew off steadily while kept to pressure through the lane. MAXXUS within striking distance behind the dueling leaders in the two path, moved closer to the winner from the outside turning for home, proved no match through the lane, clearly second best. ARKANSAS DAVE last to leave, lacked speed off the inside, mid pack through the turn, improved a bit to chase the top two through the lane, could do little with that pair the final furlong, finished up clear of the rest. CHIEF VALOR went one pace while racing three wide, improved slightly without making a significant impact. EMPIRE RANCH settled behind the pace in the second flight along the inside, moved out around a tiring rival late in the turn, came up empty for the stretch run. PRINCETON broke with the field, alternated up front for just over three furlongs along the inside, gave way midway on the turn. ROKU NANA fell back to trail after the start and was never involved.

PRAYFORPEACE broke alertly, angled in steadily soon after to tighten up RAVIN'S TOWN along the rail who in turn clipped heels, gained a daylight advantage as a result while firmly in hand, dueled into the turn while remaining inside, put the other speed away turning for home and increased his advantage while kept to pressure under a brisk hand ride. JACKMAN broke forwardly, continued close up early while off the inside, moved to challenge the winner late backstretch, dueled through the turn then could not keep up, chased past the furlong marker then was fully extended to narrowly last for the second spot. RAVIN'S TOWN broke with the leaders, maintained forward position just inside the winner soon after, was put in tight quarters by PRAYFORPEACE just before a furlong, clipped heels, fell back to race behind the dueling leaders into the turn, angled out three wide turning for home, finished willingly to be closing the gap on the runner up in the late going. VDAYTOTHETENACIOUS raced back off the early pace, asked along early in the turn, idled through the turn then improved position while racing mostly in the two path to also be gaining for the runner up position. LIGHTNING STRUCK off the pace while out in the strip, three to four wide turn, failed to respond through the lane. CAPE TRAFALGAR rank and broke out to be away slowly, continued back, four to five wide turn, fanned six wide into the lane, also failed to muster a closing response. BOAT SONG bothered to be off slowly as well, moved up to mid pack, four to five wide turn, between foes into the lane, tired in the run to the wire. FOLLOWING A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF RAVIN'S TOWN AGAINST PRAYFORPEACE FOR INTERFERENCE NEARING THE FIVE FURLONG MARK, THE LATTER WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST AND PLACED THIRD.

MIWOMAN four wide into the first turn when off the pace, stalked from the second flight in the run up the backstretch, advanced into a challenging position three wide through the second bend, engaged the leader inside the furlong marker from the outside, wore that rival down under firm handling. RANDO pressured the early leader from the outside in the three path,put a head in front before a half, continued to duel through the second bend, salted that rival away when straightened for home, responded when the winner challenged with just less than a furlong remaining and proved stubborn to the end, well clear of the others. DOZEN DIAMONDS showed the way past the wire the first time, continued to set the pace through the first turn in the two path, dueled the middle half while remaining toward the inside, first to blink entering the stretch, gradually weakened but managed to remain clear of the others. LOW KEY fell back to trail along the inside soon after the start, continued to save some ground, improved by passing some tiring rivals in upper stretch, failed to pose a serious threat. ESPERANZA'S SPIRIT back off the pace and the inside, raced three wide through the final bend, lacked a finishing kick. MYSIDEHUSTLE off a step slow, raced back and outside, four wide through the final turn, also failed to rally. AINTNOSHAKIN KID hopped at the start, chased the dueling leaders along the inside early while a bit keen in the first turn, began to weaken before six furlongs, continued to fade through the stretch.

Q'S YOUR MAMA broke back while in tight, lacked speed off the inside, moved out to be five wide behind a wall of horses turning for home, shifted out widest for the drive, roused, finished well to annex the place while remaining well out in the track. SPARKLY bumped start, forwardly placed off the inside, moved closer three wide into the turn, in tight between horses midway on the bend, fell back, set down into the stretch, regained some momentum and finished well to earn the show, not enough for the place. NGALA broke on top, settled in the second flight out in the strip, three wide most of the turn, angled out to be four wide and in tight between horses exiting the turn, lacked enough late punch to miss the show. JERI DAWN back off the pace along the inside, continued behind the lead pack turn while saving ground, improved inside of several rivals upper stretch then flattened out a bit late. MEMORY MAKER pressed the winner for a half in the two path and gave way. SHE'S STORMING back off the pace in the middle of the pack in the two path late in the turn, traffic a quarter out, tired through the lane.
