C MCGRUFF a bit keen when between horses first turn, unhurried in hand up the backstretch, closer three wide late in the final turn, saw that advance stall a bit in upper stretch, roused, late surge to wear the runner up down in the late going. FERAL forwardly placed off the inside first turn, chased the leader up the backstretch, advanced on that one in the two path far turn, took over entering the stretch, clear past the furlong marker, yielded to the winner late, held the place. DEVILISH ACT lacked speed while four wide into the first turn, angled in a bit through that bend, moved back out and raced four wide through the second bend, shifted out to the middle of the strip for the drive, finished willingly to be getting to the top two late while going best of all. NO MORE KINGS off the pace toward the inside, bit slow to settle first turn, continued toward the inside through the second bend, lacked a closing response. FATGUYINLITTLECOAT sprinted clear past the wire the first time, set the pace through some lively fractions, gave way midway on the final turn when headed. BACKSIDE last away, trailed most of the way to never menace. MCBRIDGE remained back and was never a factor.

MONTANA CAFE in the second flight while racing off the inside, fell back a bit off the two leaders while three wide turn, steered out past the furlong marker under confident handling, up in time. TIP TOE JOE broke well, dueled early off the inside, held a narrow advantage into the turn, headed with just over a quarter to run, continued to battle into the stretch closest to the inside of the top three, could not contain the winner late while coming back to earn the place. WOODSPOINT broke in mid pack, moved up into a forward position before a quarter on the outside, challenged turn, dueled into and through the stretch, held a narrow advantage past the furlong marker, also failed to hold off the winner, outkicked late for the second spot while between the pair at the wire. FAST JOKER off a step slow, continued to lack speed, steered out to be four wide into the stretch, improved position with some late interest while not a threat to the top three. RYNOTOGRACE back early, moved out three wide and made a good gain through the turn, flattened out through the stretch. CLASSICALLY forwardly placed while along the inside early, in some traffic and fell back late backstretch, went evenly through the lane in lacking a closing response. SNEAKY FEET void of early foot, angled out to be five wide into the stretch, picked off a couple of tiring rivals after the issue had been decided. SKIBIDI RIZZ vied up front in the run up the backstretch, gave way in the far turn. BLUE LINE was finished after a half while racing in the two path.

HICKO pressed the leader up the backstretch from the outside, dueled with that one far turn, took over turning for home and slowly edged away under firm steady handling. CLEAR ECHO in the second group while in the two path, crept a bit closer late in the turn, continued off the inside to be between horses with a furlong to run, finished willingly to be up late for the place, no real threat to the winner. BOTE broke out to bother STORMBENDER, was straightened to race in the second group outside the runner up, roused with that one turning into the stretch, continued on equal terms with that same rival past the furlong marker, outkicked late for the second spot, up for the show. MORE POWER narrowly showed the way up the backstretch along the inside, dueled with the winner through the turn, could not match strides with that one in the stretch, gradually weakened. COOL UNDER FIRE back off the pace outside, three to four wide through the turn when moving a bit closer, lacked a further response through the lane to finished up evenly. SAVED fell back to trail after the start, no threat. STORMBENDER reluctant to load, bothered to be off slowly, was finished before a half.

EMPATH broke sharp, raced closest to the leader, moved to engage that one through the turn, shook clear when straightened for home and maintained a daylight advantage to the wire under steady handling. LAKE LOUISE forwardly placed outside, raced four wide through the turn to lose some ground to the winner, could not get to that one in the late going, proved determined for the place. MIGHTY NORA prompted the issue up front in the three path, came with the runner up into the lane, chased the winner past the furlong marker, could do little with that one the final furlong, outkicked for the second spot. MI AMIGA off a step slow, raced back in the two path, dropped to the inside past the furlong marker and improved position. BELLA ELLA void of early foot toward the rail, steered out to be four wide exiting the turn, also bettered her position while not a serious threat. BET THE GRAY back off the early pace toward the inside, worked way out to the three path by late in the turn, displayed a mild amount of late interest, never dangerous. FRAUD ALERT forwardly placed while racing along the inside for a half, weakened through the lane. AUTHENTIC KITTEN used early to take command soon after the start, showed the way into the turn along the inside, headed by the winner late in the bend and began to weaken, continued to fade. LEAFOLOGY was finished early while racing along the inside. MACY'S MISCHIEF off slowly, trailed throughout to be always outrun.
