ICE AGAIN away well from along the inside, took control soon after, rated in the run up the backstretch through a soft half mile split, headed turning for home, set down, found more to regain the advantage with less than a furlong remaining, dueled to the wire, narrowly gained the nod. REDBIRD NATION forwardly placed while racing outside, challenged three wide second turn, gained the advantage upper stretch, dueled to the wire, missed the nod. REMEMBER THE FEAR lacked speed while four wide through the first turn, began to advance far turn while still four wide, came five wide for the drive, finished up best of the rest. WICKED MELODY in the second flight outside, moved a bit closer four wide in the second turn, went flat through the lane to finish up evenly. HUMOR ME NOW in the second flight while racing off the inside, in some traffic midway up the backstretch, idled through the final turn then went evenly through the lane to finish up evenly. IT'LL DO pressured the the winner from the outside, between the top two final turn, weakened entering the stretch and continued to fade. ROYAL COURT fell back to trail after the start while outside, four wide through the final turn, failed to muster a rally in the drive. EAST FROM WEST settled off the pace while racing three wide, had nothing for the drive. FETCHS BRAHM was finished after half.

REBEL MOON raced off the pace inside, continued to save ground when moving closer into the far turn, asked along soon after, slipped through along the rail to challenge past the furlong marker, edged clear under steady handling. STROKE THE FIRE broke back, void of speed while just off the inside, swung five wide into the stretch, finished willingly to gain the place while closing the gap on the winner. LET'S GO CHAMP dueled up front early along the inside, fell back before a half, moved out, rebid second turn, vied into the lane, held a small advantage a furlong out and proved stubborn til late. RAZORCAT in mid pack while racing off the inside, shuffled back a bit from between horses into the stretch, raced in the second flight into the lane, evenly late in lacking a closing punch. MAJOR MACK within striking distance out in the strip, closer three to four wide through the final turn, weakened when the real running began at the head of the lane. HALFWAY TEMPTED back in the main body toward the inside, in some traffic midway on the second bend in the two path, came up empty when clear for the drive. STUDENY dueled early, shook well clear before a half, held a narrow advantage into the far turn then began to weaken when headed into the stretch. BOLT'S TREASURE off a step slow, remained back in failing to threaten. AWOL back off the pace and the inside, floated out four to five wide turning for home, gave way in the run to the wire.

MOON OVER CHOCTAW vied early while between horses, pressed the pace up the backstretch, fell back off that one turning for home and through upper stretch, came again late to run down that same rival. KERRY'S KISS broke on top, narrowly showed the way through the first turn along the inside, slightly larger advantage up the backstretch, shook clear into the stretch, could not last. MADDIENLIZZYSHONOR off a step slow, raced back, began to move in the two path second turn from between horses, continued that mild rally to be clear for the show at the end. ST. ALBANS RAID broke out, raced back off the early pace three wide, moved closer with a four wide move through the second turn, within striking distance turning for home, flattened out in the run to the wire. FALL IN LOVE off a step slow, raced back, angled four wide turning for home, improved through upper stretch then continued mildly to the finish. FROSTED MIRACLE behind the pace inside, continued to save ground, had little for the drive. MY SHOT forced the pace outside, three wide into the far turn when still close, gave way soon after. LOTTERY TICKET in mid pack in the three path, stopped in the far turn, jogged in.

TOUCHDOWN ARKANSAS with the pace while four wide up the backstretch and into the turn, gained a clear advantage into the lane while angling in a bit, extended that advantage past the furlong marker then held the runner up comfortably safe late. CAMPISI back off the lead pack up the backstretch outside, closer four wide turning into the stretch, chased the winner past the furlong marker and was not a serious threat while slowly carving into that one's advantage late. WAR MULE came out early, raced behind the leaders along the inside, moved off the rail into the turn, staged a rally through the lane to gain the show, well clear of the others. GETTINBY lacked speed off the inside, angled out a bit to be three wide into the lane, staged a mild rally to improve position. BRAHMS IMAGE vied up front along the inside, fell back off the lead pack through the turn, went evenly through the lane. LANDLORD with the pace while between horses, weakened through the stretch. CHEZ WHIZ broke back, trailed early, passed some tiring foes through the lane with some belated interest. HAYAHLOOKATME with the pace while three wide and between horses for a half, faltered in the drive. MAX DOT SOCKS bothered early,

steadied, raced well back, got out a bit then steadied into the turn, did not threaten. ROCKET SANDERS in mid pack while four wide through the turn, tired. DEBATER remained back while moving out three wide through the turn. SPOONMAN remained always back.
