OPPOSITE THE CROWD forwardly placed while outside, took over turning for home, kicked clear under steady handling. LEGALLY CHARITABLE with early pace, relinquished the advantage to SPITE LITE before a quarter, asked along between that one and the winner late in the turn, proved no match for that one the final furlong, kicked clear for the place. SPITE LITE off a step slow, moved up along the inside to show the way into the turn inside, faltered when headed turning for home. COLLECTED GLORY void of early foot, knifed through three wide between rivals turning for home, lacked a further advance to finish up evenly. MIESHA in the second flight, floated out four wide turning for home, lacked a closing kick. SISTER ELLA in mid pack off rail, in some traffic late backstretch, had little for the drive. CHIP SHORTAGE in the second flight inside, faded through the stretch.

BERTIE'S CAUSE outrun in the early going off the inside, swung five wide into the stretch, finished full of run to win going away while remaining well out in the strip. BACKED BY GOLD in mid pack while outside, came four wide and inside the winner turning for home, bump, bothered upper stretch by a lugging CANKTON'S COWGIRL, up late for the place. SHE'S STORMING closest to the leader up the backstretch in the two path, continued to chase into the lane, shifted out, no match winner, caught late for the place. LADY OF DEVON one paced off the inside, continued in the two path into the stretch, improved a bit late while not posing a serious threat. KITIARA broke on top, quickly sprinted clear to set the pace, maintained daylight through the stretch, weakened late then was not persevered with in the final to strides to lose an additional spot. CHARMONTE last away, trailed for five furlongs then picked off a couple of faltering rivals after the issue had been decided. CANKTON'S COWGIRL in the second flight three wide, lugged out and bumped the runner up with three sixteenths to run, rider lost whip a furlong out, gave way. THE PRINCESS SAYS in mid pack and inside, faded through the lane.

RED FLAG broke back, void of speed out off the inside, raced three to four wide into the lane, shifted out a bit more and closed with a flourish down the middle of the strip to be in time. GLENGARRY broke sharp, soon got clear and toward the inside, showed the way through the lane in the two path, repelled a bid from CHIRINGO in upper stretch to gain a slightly larger advantage, held RYVITI save from the inside, nailed in the final strides while gaining the nod over RUN CLASSIC for the place. RUN CLASSIC in mid pack and off the inside, two to three wide into the stretch, late run through some traffic to finish willingly, missed the nod for the place. RYVITI broke with the field, raced forwardly and inside, remained within striking distance while continuing to save ground into the lane, lacked a closing punch the final furlong. DEVIL'S TOWER behind horses while toward the rail for a half, moved out four wide into the lane, went evenly in lacking a closing response. CHIRINGO prompted the issue early, challenged outside the runner up in the three path through the turn and into the stretch, faltered in the drive. FROSTED DEPARTURE settled off the pace and the inside, three wide through the turn, had little left for the drive. SIR WELLINGTON off a step slow, remained back. SPANKSTER was finished after a half.
