MAGIC MOVER broke alertly, showed the way in the two path through the first turn, rated the middle half, rebroke through the stretch to be well clear, geared down late to win ridden out. CHARMING TIGER off slow, lacked speed, to advance 2nd turn, angled four wide into the lane, could do little with the winner through the lane, well clear for the place. SPEECHLESS closest to the winner from the outside, moved a bit closer late in the final turn, flattened out for the stretch run, no match for the runner up, well clear of the others. AUDAX MINOR four wide into the first turn, raced wide through the second bend, went evenly through the lane in lacking a closing response. PRIMO CANARY bothered slightly and was floated out six wide into the first turn, angled in a bit and was four wide onto the backstretch, continued in the four path final turn, displayed a mild amount of late interest to improved slightly. NOBLE REIGN broke outward and awkwardly, remained back and inside, angled out three wide midway on the final turn, failed to rally. VINO VIDICI forwardly placed early along the inside, staged a steady retreat after a half. GONNA PICK DOMENIC in mid pack and three wide, stopped in the final turn, well beaten.

ALOHA BABY in the second flight up the backstretch in the two path, tipped out four wide late in the turn, engaged the leader from the outside nearing the furlong marker, wore that one down under firm handling. CHAPTER AND VERSE vied up front while three wide early, dueled turn, disposed of that foe when straightened for home, responded when challenged by the winner with a furlong to run, gave ground grudgingly to that foe. UNION DAME in mid pack while saving ground, continued along the inside through the turn, staged a mild rail rally to be clear of the others, not a serious threat to the top pair. FOXY'S HONOR with the early pace inside, fell back off the other speed turn, moved out for the drive, went evenly to the wire. MOENCHANTED with the pace while between horses up the backstretch, dueled turn inside the runner up, weakened through the stretch. LINE RUNNER off a step slow, raced back outside, four wide through the turn, failed to muster a rally through the lane. SIMPLE DREAMS went one paced from two to three path. DARETOCATCHLOVE off a step slow, void of speed, improved a bit while five wide into the stretch, flattened out. OUR SPECIAL GIFT fell back to trail after the start, four wide turning for home, not a threat in the drive. RANCH REBEL was never involved while racing toward the inside. SYDNEY'S JOY veered out at the start, mid pack and three wide, stopped.

RED ROUTE ONE outrun in the early going inside, continued to save ground under patient handling the middle half mile, began to creep closer in the far turn, moved out a bit soon after then dropped back to the rail late in the final bend, knifed out three wide to hit an opening in upper stretch under clever handling, reached the leaders soon after and drew well clear under firm and steady handling. TARANTINO broke running, helped set a quick opening quarter along the rail, shuffled back late in the first turn, moved out three wide, advanced and lodged a rebid midway on the second turn, gained the advantage into the stretch, proved no match for the winner while clearly second best. SPEED BIAS settled off the pace in the two path, steered out to be four wide turning for home when moving a bit closer, up late for the show, not a threat to the top two. PATRIOT SPIRIT vied up front between horses past the wire the first time, dueled the middle half mile closest to the inside, weak4ened in the drive. KINETIC back off the pace three wide, moved four wide in the second turn, came up empty for the drive. UNLOAD threw head at the start to be off slow, moved up quickly afterward, helped set a quick set of early fractions, stopped midway on the final turn, lost touch with the field through the lane and jogged in.

WHERE'S RANDY five wide through most of the first turn back early, advanced four wide onto the backstretch, continued four wide into the far turn, moved

to challenge while working his way to the three path, gained a narrow advantage inside the furlong grounds between horses, lugged out twice late to bother POINT BLANK then held that foe and REVEILLE VALLEY safe late. REVEILLE VALLEY set the early pace just off the inside, got briefly clear into the far turn, continued to do battle while closest to the rail of the first flight past the furlong marker, could not get to WHERE'S RANDY LATE while narrowly holding off POINT BLANK at the wire. POINT BLANK in tight at the break to be away slowly, raced well back for five furlongs, big move five wide into contention second turn, came four wide for the drive, challenged outside past the furlong marker, bothered twice late by a lugging WHERE'S RANDY, continued with resolve to the finish to narrowly miss the second spot. DOUBLECHECK bobbed, bumped and pinched to also be off slowly, raced well back, made a five wide move behind POINT BLANK out of the final turn, slowly closing the gap on that one late. CLEAR ECHO behind the pace just off the inside, in some traffic into the far turn, went evenly through the stretch in lacking a closing. STORM STRATEGY ducked out at the start to bother a couple of outer rivals, lacked speed, came four wide for the drive, bettered position without posing a serious threat. OUTLAW RUN lacked speed while four wide through the first turn, continued in mid pack, four to five wide through the second bend, one paced through the lane. STUCK N SNOW in the main group while off the inside, traffic late in the final turn, failed to muster a rally when clear for the drive. TOO TWENTYTWO forwardly placed while three wide, continued in striking position second turn, yielded through the lane. GEE NO HOLLANDER lacked early foot toward the rail, fell back to trail into the second turn, no factor. HOLUS BOLUS four wide in the first turn, in some traffic with three quarters to run, began to fade after a half. MONEYSTRIKE prompted the issue up front for almost six furlongs along the inside, stopped. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE RUN THROUGH LATE STRETCH AND A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF POINT BLANK AGAINST WHERE'S RANDY FOR INTERFERENCE, THE LATTER WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST AND PLACED THIRD.
