WITHOUT OBJECTION broke well, narrowly set the pace from along the inside, continued to hold a small advantage into the stretch, long stretch duel, dug in late to narrowly prevail in a game effort. MR PUK pressed the issue up the backstretch while between horses, dueled out of the turn and into the stretch, extended duel, outkicked late. PRINCIPE CARLO behind the pace while along the inside, waited and was covered up and boxed throughout the turn, continued in traffic with a furlong to run, shifted out but was unable to close the gap on the top pair late. SUMMER SPLASH in the second flight while racing outside, crept a bit closer to the lead pack late in the turn, lost some ground to the top two as a result and was also unable to do much with the top two through the lane. COUNT DE MONET fell back to trail after the start, continued to lack speed in the two path through the turn, failed to respond in the drive. HEY EUGENE pressured the pace from the three path for a half and gave way. WIND OF CHANGE (BRZ) in mid pack while racing off the rail, had little for the drive. DRIFTER remained always back.

G. ERIK bothered at the start to be away slowly, moved up while out in the strip up the backstretch, checked up in tight quarters entering the turn, quickly recover to advance four wide and put a head in front by late in the turn, came three wide for the drive, clear past the furlong marker and then held the runner up safe late under steady handling to prove clearly best. REAL BLUES forwardly placed off the inside, raced under a firm hold in tight quarters into and through the far turn, forwardly placed three wide behind the winner entering the stretch, chased that one home while holding sway late for the second spot. MIRACLE ON CENTRAL within striking distance the opening quarter while covered up along the inside, shuffled back on the rail early turn, moved off the inside for the drive, steadily closing the gap on the top two late in finishing up willingly. FINE TUNED broke well, raced with the pace three wide and between horses, continued to vie into the lane inside the winner, gradually weakened to lose a couple of positions through the stretch. Z BOSS lacked early foot off the inside, four to five wide turning for home, dove to the inside when straightened for home and improved position. E MONEY away in good order, moved up to take command and show the way up the backstretch and into the turn in the two path, faltered late in the bend. MAX MISCHIEF floated out five wide toward the front by the winner entering the turn, four wide into the stretch, lacked a closing kick in an even effort. SILVER FALCON with the early pace

while along the inside, began a steady fade before a half while saving ground. ALWAYS FIRST broke back and was never threatened while four wide through the turn. WORK BOOTS broke a step slow and never menaced. MALACHI stumbled and then broke out to be away slowly, remained always back. VSOP bothered at the start, fell far back, eventually lost contact with the field, jogged in.

A P RULY broke alertly, raced with the pace three wide up the backstretch, dueled through the turn off the inside, put the other speed away to be clear in upper stretch, maintained daylight to the wire under steady handling. LORD OF RHYMES behind the first flight in the two path backstretch, crept slightly closer late in the turn, in some traffic entering the stretch, clear when chasing past the furlong marker, slowly closing the gap on the winner late. VINEY vied

up front early between horses and inside the winner, dueled with that one through the turn, slowly weakened in the run to the wire, managed to save the show. BOTE in the second flight early, asked along three wide outside the runner up through the turn, went evenly through the lane. PERFECT DIAL raced back off the pace and the inside, three to four wide through the turn, lacked a closing punch. CHROMERUNNER broke back, lacked speed outside, four to five wide through the turn, improved upper stretch then flattened out the final furlong. COOL AND CLOUDY settled off the pace toward the inside early, raced four wide out of the turn, brushed with GO GO RO RO in upper stretch, late burst outside the late leader to be up in time. GET AWAY WITH IT reluctant to load, raced back off the early pace, advanced into a striking position three to four wide late in the turn, wore the leader down down to put a head in front with a furlong to run, could not contain the winner. GO GO RO RO broke back, raced outside well off the pace, four wide into the turn, three wide and inside the winner entering the stretch, brushed with that one while in some traffic, raced on equal terms with that same rival past the furlong marker then could not keep up while getting up late for the show. LORD HENNESSY pressed the leader from the three path, challenged that one inside the runner up turning into the stretch, briefly duelled then began to weaken. BIG COUNTRY BOY back off the

pace while well out in the strip, four to five wide through the turn, improved position with some mild interest down the lane. COACH SAM P lacked early foot while toward the inside, improved position a bit while no real threat. STILLBILLY went evenly while working way from the rail to the three path through the turn. RAZORBACK ARMY forwardly placed along the inside for a half, weakened through the stretch. IMO THE BEST bothered and was off slowly, raced back, picked off a couple of tiring rivals. DENALI LIGHTNING in the second flight for a half in the two path, gave way in the drive. HEY MISTER broke out to bother IMO THE BEST, was straightened to show the way up the backstretch and into the turn in the two path, caved in when headed entering the stretch. ANGELSNBUTTERFLIES fell back to trail after the start and was never a factor.
