LAMBETH away well from the outside, took over before a half, clear while rating kindly in the run down the stretch the first time, continued in hand onto the backstretch, maintained a daylight advantage into the third turn, let out a notch entering the stretch, plenty left to hold a comfortable advantage to the wire. GAME WARDEN never far back off the inside, chased the winner to that one's outside, also called on for run into the stretch the second time, could do little with the winner, far clear of the others.
