LUNDBERG in the second flight along the inside, confidently handled while shifted out in the two path late in the turn, switched out to be four wide when straightened for home, set down, closed with good determination to lodge an outside bid late, up in time. SANTOS DUMONT off a step slow, moved up into the second group outside the winner, angled three wide and challenged into the stretch, shook off those two foes to be clear past the furlong marker, led late, caught. MACRON void of speed outside, four out to five wide by midway on the turn, rallied down the center of the strip to be in time for the show, not a serious threat to the top two. MIDNIGHT PRANKS in mid pack while off the inside, came in the two path out of the turn, improved through upper stretch, outkicked late for the show. VALE vied up front closest to the inside, gradually weakened through the lane. BRON AND BROW off the pace and the inside,

three wide through the bend,improved position a bit in the drive without posing a serious threat. SWEET AS SIN prompted the issue early three wide, fell back through the turn, went evenly through the stretch. MAGIA NERA off a step slow, trailed for a half, three wide through the turn, improved position by passing mostly tiring rivals. UNPREDICTABLE BAY also broke slowly, made little impact toward the inside. BETTYS CASH three to four wide through the turn, had little left for the stretch run. LORD OF RHYMES in the second flight while between horses up the backstretch, fell back in some traffic turn, tipped out three wide in upper stretch, bid, took over, held runner up safe late under firm handling. GETTINBY broke back, moved out while lacking speed, four to five wide through the turn, set down mid track, slowly getting to the winner late. ROCK SOLO broke in, settled behind the pace inside the winner, angled out in front of that one to challenge late in the turn, vied past midstretch then was outkicked late by the top two. HICKO off a step slow, raced back while inside, continued to save ground through the turn, traffic upper, moved back to the inside and showed some mild interest to the wire. MAX DOT SOCKS fell back to trail just after the start, continued to lag backstretch, asked along far turn, came in the two path for the drive and displayed some belated interest to improve position. A P RULY away in good order, dueled up front in the two path for a half and faltered. SWEET FANTASY broke alertly, helped set the pace along the inside for four furlongs and also weakened when the real running began at the head of the lane. WAR MULE forwardly placed outside, four wide through the turn, gave way in upper stretch, jodged in.
