SPEAKING LOUD in the second flight toward the inside, moved into the two path mid turn, blocked all of upper stretch, dropped in just past the eighth pole, finished full of run to be well clear at the end. KENSINGTON COVE back off the pace and the inside, asked along late turn in the four path, displayed some good mettle to finish willingly and gain the place while between horses at the wire. LORD HENNESSY dueled up front while off the inside, put the other speed away as he was being challenged in upper stretch, weakened late to lose the second spot. MARKANSAS mid pack outside, four wide turn, came five wide for the drive, displayed some mild interest late while widest of the first group. GO GO RO RO in the second flight while outside the winner, three wide

bid late in the turn, held a narrow advantage past the furlong marker, faltered late. MANDATORY MISSION settled in the main body off the inside, two path through the turn, moved out a bit for the drive, went evenly to the wire. GREY STREET broke back, lacked speed, two path turn, improved position in the drive without posing a serious threat. OINK broke in and slowly, lagged well back early, four wide midway on the turn, also bettered his position with some belated interest. IMO THE BEST went one paced throughout while racing three out to four wide. GET AWAY WITH IT saved ground to no avail. DAWSON JAMES dueled up front closest to the inside, gave way turning into the stretch. UNCLE TATER reluctant to load, four out to five wide turn, backed up.
