PHABULOUS PHOEBE stumbled at the start then was allowed to settle in the early stages, advanced two to three wide at the quarter marker, could not sustain that run into the stretch and did not threaten in the final stages. DIANE'S MERLOT broke alertly and set a prompted pace up the backstretch, led into the turn then was overtaken midway along the bend, chased from the rail into upper stretch and gave way in the drive.

GOOD FRIDAY MAN stalked the early pace two wide and from between runners, was well placed to the far turn then was boxed in at the quarter pole, found room along the rail into upper stretch and vied for the lead at the furlong grounds, stubbornly battled to the final sixteenth then was outfinished in deep stretch and held safely for second. LUCKY DOUBLE ZERO allowed to settle early on while never far back, was caught four to five wide into the backstretch, chased three wide nearing the quarter pole then battled four wide into upper stretch, was outkicked into deep stretch and was well clear of the rest for third. VIRAL VIDEO tracked the early pace from the inside, lost position passing the half-mile marker, trailed into the far turn and could not muster a response in the stretch drive. GREAT COMPOSER hopped at the start, was a bit keen into the first turn then pulled on the rider to make a three wide middle move along the backstretch, contested the pace to the second turn, could not keep pace into upper stretch and came up empty through the final furlong.



MALIBU WARRIOR stalked the early pace three deep, went up and prompted PAYNTER'S PRODIGY through moderate fractions heading to the half-mile marker, dueled into the far turn then battled BOOSTER SHOT into the stretch, took a narrow lead into the final sixteenth, was tagged for the win in the final strides and held for second. BOOSTER SHOT broke alertly then ceded the early lead heading to the first turn, tracked the moderate pace to the half-mile marker, bid three wide into the far turn then took command into upper stretch, led past the furlong marker, could not hold off rivals into the final sixteenth and was outfinished for the win and place, while well clear of the rest for the show. THIRD WATCH bobbled at the start and was away a bit slowly, settled while saving ground then inched closer to the leaders along the backstretch, chased two to three wide into the far turn and came within range at the quarter marker, could not sustain that run into the stretch. RIVERBOAT BANDIT raced close up to the early pace while four wide, tracked the moderate pace three wide to the half-mile pole, was outrun along the second turn then gave way through the stretch. EYES ELEVEN settled two wide into the first turn, was unhurried through the backstretch, saved ground into the far turn then trailed the rest of the way.

SAMS AFTER PARTY hustled for the early lead, set a contested pace to the turn, met the bid of HOT ROD KITTY into upper stretch, held that foe at bay to the furlong marker, dueled gamely to the final sixteenth and was bested for the win in the final strides, while well clear of the rest for second. NICOLE'S WILL pressed the early pace from outside of SAMS AFTER PARTY, dueled into the turn then vied for the lead two wide and between foes at the quarter pole, lost position into upper stretch, chased the leading pair through the final furlong and held safely for third. EXTRASEXYMCSTEEMEE was off slowly, recovered and chased the pace three to four wide into the turn, could not keep pace into the stretch and weakened in the drive. CHILLING TIME settled while saving ground and did not offer a late rally.

WHEN YOUR STRANGE vied for the early lead then lost position heading to the half-mile marker, chased three wide into the turn and mounted a four wide rally into the stretch, could not impact the winner into the final sixteenth but finished well and was second best. LA MACCHINA ROSSA settled off of the early pace while never far back, saved ground into the turn then chased two wide into the stretch, was able to close into the final sixteenth and won the nod for third on the wire. TILTED TIARA raced close up to the early pace, went up and pressed the pace outside of ARUMA heading into the turn, took command along the bend then battled LADRO DI FICHI into upper stretch, could not match strides with the winner into the final furlong, yielded in the drive and just missed for third. BROAD JUMPER allowed to settle in the early stages, ran in pursuit four to five wide into upper stretch and did not factor in the final furlong. ARUMA showed good early speed, contested the pace from the inside heading to the turn, lost position midway through the bend, chased into upper stretch then faded in the drive.

RUN HELWIG RUN forwardly placed in the early stages, stalked the pace while saving ground into the turn, loomed at the quarter marker then drew clear into the stretch while in hand, widened the lead at the furlong pole and was geared down in the final sixteenth to win as much the best. MOBOT allowed to settle while saving ground early on, maintained an inside trip to the stretch, could not impact the winner into the final furlong but was able to close well in deep stretch and bested the rest for second. DASHING HONCHO crowded a neighboring rival leaving the start, showed good early speed and set a prompted pace heading to the half-mile marker, dictated terms into the turn while in the two path, was overtaken by RUN HELWIG RUN nearing the quarter pole then lugged out into upper stretch, chased the winner through the lane and was outkicked for third in the late stages. CANDY'S MAJESTY broke in at the start then was crowded by a neighboring rival and was off a bit slowly, recovered to prompt the early pace from outside of DASHING HONCHO, pressed that rival three wide into the turn, was carried out wide into upper stretch when DASHING HONCHO lugged out leaving the quarter marker then lacked a response in the lane and weakened in deep stretch.
