

SANDY'S REFUGEE set a pressured pace inside of WILLY WILLY while in the two to three path on the turn then was headed and dueled with that rival by the quarter pole, came three wide off the bend and drifted out leaving the furlong marker while edging clear and remained clear at the wire while continuing to drift to the center of the track at the wire. BEWARE OF PRIDE chased the early pace, dropped to the inside on the turn and waited nearing the quarter pole, came two wide off the bend and finished well towards the inside. PEARL OF ACLAIM (GB) tracked the pace and was three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the lane to make a bid but needed more late. WILLY WILLY pressed the early pace outside the winner, made a three to four wide bid to duel for command to the furlong marker but faded. WIZARDOFEZ stumbled slightly at the break, chased the pace and was wide on the turn, came six wide into the lane and had no rally. SCRAPPY T LEE was close up early and then moved to the inside to track the pace on the turn and weakened in the drive.

Footnotes | <u>View Glossary Of Terms</u> EPISTEME dueled for the lead on the outside of TAPAS WARRIOR, made a bid leaving the seven-sixteenths to shake clear on the turn while in the two path, then was challenged by MUMMALICIOUS leaving the turn to the furlong marker but repelled that bid and once again drew clear to prove best under right handed crop urging. MUMMALICIOUS lunged at the break and was off slow, moved out to make a three wide move on the turn to loom boldly leaving the turn but hung in the final furlong while being clearly second best. TAPAS WARRIOR dueled for the lead on the inside, fell back on the turn, swung out four wide leaving the turn and bested the rest. LITTLE FIDDLE tracked the pace on the inside and weakened. FATALIST tracked the pace two to three wide and weakened.

PREACH IT WARRIOR set the pace on the inside and was well handled, headed nearing the quarter pole, turned back the bid and shook clear with a furlong to go and then maintained a safe margin to the wire to prove best under a drive. TUFF LUCK was rated between rivals, three wide by the quarter pole and angled out leaving the turn and closed well but could not get to the winner while gaining the place award. ENAHM was four wide into the first turn, rated on the outside and made a three wide move to go on even terms by the quarter pole but flattened out nearing the furlong marker while staying on to best the rest. CODY PASS chased the pace on the inside and weakened. SUNSHINE JOHNNY was off a step slow, settled early and was four to three path on the far turn and had no rally. CHUCK ADAMS stalked the pace two wide and fell back on the far turn, tired.

DONNELLY'S HOLLOW was rated along the outside, made a three wide bid by the quarter pole to vie for command, then took over leaving the turn and kicked away to prove best under a drive. VOLODYMYR was allowed to settle early towards the inside, advanced two to three path on the far turn and came four wide off the bend and ran on willingly but could not gain on the winner in the final furlong while clearly second best. LUCKY DOUBLE ZERO bumped a rival at the break, then was reserved early, moved to the outside on the first turn and advanced four wide on the far turn and came five wide into the lane and improved position gaining the show award. MAGIC PATH was bumped at the start, then tracked the pace on the inside, shuffled back on the far turn and came two wide into the lane and improved late to gain the last spot in the superfecta. OLLIE BOY pressed the pace three wide and made a two wide bid to lead briefly but weakened in the drive. COME ABOUT set a pressured pace on the inside and gave way on the far turn. MANHATTAN CHARLIE was fractious in the gate, bumped at the break and chased the early pace in between rivals and fell back readily and stopped.
