BOLT OF PARADISE chased the pace and tracked the leaders on the inside on the turn, cut the corner leaving the turn and made a inside bid to edge clear in the final sixteenth to prove best under a drive. WUDHOOH stalked the early pace from between rivals, three path on the turn and came four wide into the lane and finished well. MOCHA DIANE pressed the early pace and was two wide on the turn, came three wide off the bend and ran on to the wire while in between rivals the final sixteenth. SEAP dueled and set a pressured pace on the inside, came two wide off the bend and dug in to the the sixteenth marker and faded. ECLIPTICAL GINA was off a step slow, saved ground on the turn and cut the corner leaving the turn and angled out in the lane and had a mild late rally but needed more late. QUALIFIED HIRE was settled back early, three path on the turn and lacked a rally. DON DIVA stalked the pace four wide and steadied leaving the three eighths marker and weakened. GOLDEN STYLE ]broke in and bumped a rival at the break, chased the pace on the outside and was five wide on the turn and weakened. KENTUCKY REIGN was bumped soundly at the break, chased the pace four to three wide and weakened.

ME DARLIN KATHLEEN tracked the pace and made a inside bid to gain a short lead leaving the turn but faded in the final furlong, held show. UTTERLY ENCHANTING was reserved early and saved ground on the turn, swung out four wide leaving the turn and had a mild late rally. SHEHERHERS stalked the pace three wide and came four wide off the bend and weakened in the lane. SULTRY SALLY H set the pace while clear and raced on the inside to the two path on the turn and was headed leaving the quarter pole and came up empty in the drive.
