MAJOR THOMAS , away well, rated back off an outer foe and tucked up inside and in hand, tracked patiently through the backstretch run, eased out mid way on the final turn then rolled up in hand to engage the leader from the outside, forged to command leaving the three sixteenths, drifted in briefly soon after, responded to firm asking and spurted away then was geared down very late. CRAZY KATER settled off the pace while inside, waited briefly leaving the far turn, gained along the rail past the five sixteenths, swung out four to five wide in upper stretch, closed nicely outside rivals and nabbed the place. DECLARATION TIME saved ground under rating, edged up past the five sixteenths, eased out, chased inside foes past mid stretch then continued on willingly between rivals though nipped for second. KBCYA LATER hopped at the break, recovered and sped up to take command outside foes then cleared, secured the inside and set the pace, came under a ride when encountered near the quarter pole, fought on inside the winner from the three sixteenths to leaving mid stretch then gave way grudgingly. BODE'S MAKER , unhurried early, steadied off heels near the quarter pole, regrouped then swung out for the drive and offered belated interest. MONSTER MASON lost ground four wide, edged up outside runners near the half, chased to mid stretch then faded. ZIPPY GIZMO hesitated at the break, lost ground four wide from the five eighths to upper stretch, shifted in near mid stretch but failed to menace. WHISKEYMAC , three deep and forwardly placed around the first turn, stalked into the far turn, lacked a punch past the five sixteenths and weakened. JACK SLYE , between foes and close up around the first turn, rated back off rivals near the five eighths, edged back up between runners near the half, failed to kick on leaving the far turn and faltered. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

NEON SIGN accelerated to the inside of a rival and took over after a sixteenth of a mile, cleared soon after and set a rated pace, spurted away after being roused in upper stretch then held firm under a drive. BERMUDA RUN , four wide early, chased three wide outside a rival approaching the stretch, kept on with willing pursuit and was clearly second best. TWENTYEIGHTTOTHREE , inside and behind rivals nearing the half, dropped back several lengths leaving the three eighths, remained inside into and through the lane, kicked back in near mid stretch and finished with good effort to get the show. MR SANDMAN broke outward but on top, corrected and stalked the pace, was urged between runners leaving the three eighths, chased to the inside of a rival nearing the stretch and faded. MASK PATROL rushed up inside runners leaving the five eighths, took closer order near the half, was under pressure to the inside of a pair of runners leaving the far turn, faded past the five sixteenths then swung out for the drive. ENFORCER , forwardly placed between rivals early, eased back then angled out leaving the far turn, circled four wide and faded.

BRAMBLE BUSH , away well, rated back off the leaders and saved ground in close attendance, was pushed along past the five sixteenths, took advantage of an inside seam soon into the lane, forged clear under a drive then widened while kept to task. APPLE SHAKE SHAKE settled off the pace, crept closer while saving ground into the far turn, chased while saving ground past the five sixteenths, remained inside from there and finished up willingly to gain the place. NEVER SO LUCKY (IRE) , four to five wide, was floated out leaving mid stretch and churned on. CINDY'S SONG , under firm rating tracking three wide, bid three deep into the far turn, pressed four wide into the stretch, was carried out some past mid stretch then flattened out late between horses. CALL ON CLARA broke a bit slow, steadied and angled out to avoid SCOTT ALAIA entering the first turn, regrouped and raced far back to the lane, swung out past mid stretch then had belated actions outside rivals. LOUELLA STREET prompted the pace outside PLEASE MARRY ME, applied more pressure racing between runners exiting the far turn, remained a presence three wide into the lane, was floated out in mid stretch and faded. PLEASE MARRY ME cleared early, set the pace towards the inside and took pressure past the five eighths, was hounded by outer foes leaving the three eighths, drifted out a path clinging to the lead into the lane, drifted further out near mid stretch and tired. SCOTT ALAIA . squeezed back soon after the break, was pulled up around the first turn, walked off then was transported off the track via the equine ambulance.

FIRE DOWN BELOW was sent up to the inside of a pair of foes and took command heading to the half, edged clear under coaxing around the turn, entered the lane about two wide, increased his lead under strong handling past mid stretch then held firm. CHAIN REACTION , three wide prompting outside foes, gave hard chase of the winner from the head of the lane, failed to make serious inroads through the final furlong but kept on with good effort to be clear of the rest. EDDIEMUSH steadied at the break, was urged along off the pace, angled seven wide for the drive and closed willingly. GANGLY , brushed at the break, circled the turn four wide, pursued past mid stretch then flattened out. ROCKIN THE PALACE , in close at the break, raced well off the pace into the turn, chased two wide mid turn, angled out then lacked a strong bid. ABBY'S SPIRIT saved ground, edged up mid turn, chased into the stretch then faded. MIGHTY MINION was taken back soon after the break, saved ground under early rating and failed to menace. PYLON bobbled at the break, recovered and sped to an early lead, ceded command to the inner winner nearing the half, stayed on to chase two wide to the head of the lane then gave way.
