HIGHS N GOES hustled from the break, made the lead with only one in close pursuit, responded when roused at the top of the stretch and drew off under brisk handling. GENTLE BREEZE stalked the pacesetter through the turn, then was unable to match strides in the stretch while holding safe for the place. THICK AND JUICY broke outward, bothering RUN HELWIG RUN, rushed up after being a little slow into stride, got an inside run through the turn, bobbled near the three-sixteenth marker but finished up well to take the third prize. WIZARDOFEZ tracked four wide from the middle of the pack, started a bid midway on the turn, raced on the left lead down the stretch and flattened out. SOCIAL ACCEPTANCE tracked three-wide in mid-pack and finished evenly. KEVIN MAC veered in after the start and bumped into RUN HELWIG RUN, outpaced in the early stages, settled at the rear of the main pack, steadied in traffic near the three-furlong pole, came back, tipped out to the three path for the stretch run, but could not make up the lost ground. RUN HELWIG RUN took up when THICK AND JUICE came over into the path at the start then was immediately bumped off-stride by KEVIN MAC, chased at the back through the turn, and was kept to task through the stretch. ENGLISH DADDY was hustled away but unable to join the early pace battle, retreated through the field, then took up heading into the turn, lost momentum and was unable to recover.

BALLAD OF WARRIOR stalked a rival down the backstretch on the rail, moved out to the three path to launch a bid midway on the turn, put a head in front leaving the quarter pole while under confident handling, then held clear down the stretch under intermittent urging. PARTY AT SAM'S broke best, led the way down the backstretch two-deep with BALLAD OF WARRIOR always in close attendance, was challenged by the rival approaching the quarter pole, fought back under strong handling and urging, but had to settle for second best while clear of the next finisher. ROAN BURGUNDY broke out at the start and was last in the initial stages, advanced down the backstretch to be with striking distance of the leaders on the turn, kept to the inside and launched a rally under steady handling, was no match for the top pair in the stretch but kept on well to win the race for third while drifting out a bit in the later stages. STRAWBERRY TREAT was the distant trailer early, then made a mild late rally after the issue had already been decided up front. UNIFIED BY CANDY lost the path just after the start, steadied, then chased three wide close up to the turn, was unable to quicken with the top two from the three-furlong pole, then tired in the final furlong.

MYCROFT settled inside just behind the pace, content with that position to the far turn, then became boxed in a waited until the stretch, split horses at the head of the lane, finished up well and made the front inside the sixteenth pole. GORDITO was off a beat slow but recovered to race just behind the leading pair thurgh the first turn, raced close up to the half-mile pole then moved up to put some pressure on the leaders, bid three-wide midway on the turn then went a little wide turning for home, was under strong handling and urging but could not get to the winner while winning the race for second. QUAMASH broke out sharply at the start then overcorrected and bothered CALL ME REX a few strides from the gate, still managed to make the front before the first turn, led the way down the backstretch under mild pressure, tried to quicken with three furlongs to run, came into the stretch with a clear lead then weakened inside the sixteenth pole. LUCKY DOUBLE ZERO lost the path at the start and spotted the field a head start, raced far behind the rest through the early stages, then started to advance as the field approached the half-mile mark, continued to improve through the turn, finished with some energy, but was not good enough to threaten. LEMON BREEZE got away well and was guided to the front, pulled three wide through the clubhouse turn to settle just off the flank of QUAMASH on the lead, quickened on cue from the three-furlong pole, then went flat in upper stretch and finished even-paced. CALL MEE REX took up shortly after the start when QUAMASH came over, was not asked for any speed for the first half, bid three wide into the stretch but was unable to improve. COME ABOUT settled in mid-pack for the first half-mile, came under a ride with three furlongs to run, but was overtaken late in the stretch and had little to give in the later stages.

SUNDAY GILT was not asked for speed from the break, settled inside well behind the pace duel up front, made a four-wide sweeping move on the far turn to bid for the lead at the top of the stretch, came under pressure but was no match for the winner, kept on under steady handling to save the place.
