BONITA LASSIE rated kindly three wide stalking the pace, was given her cue approaching the stretch, leveled off to her best stride leaving the furlong grounds, rolled up outside the leader with seventy yards to go, wrested command soon after and drove clear. BETCHA BOOTS BABE pulled clear early, set a rated pace two wide, responded when asked soon into the lane, remained well clear under a drive leaving the furlong grounds, could not resist the winner's outer charge but kept on well to the wire. FOREST MAIDEN, three wide chasing, angled out six to seven wide in upper stretch and closed steadily. HIGH VIBES saved ground pursuing the leaders, remained inside through the lane, moved up past the furlong grounds then flattened out. MY BOSS LADY, four wide mid turn, was outrun.
