Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

UNCLE ARLYS, fractious in the gate, pulled clear early then dropped in to set the pace, was joined into the far turn, sparred inside a pair of rivals from the five sixteenths to upper stretch, shook clear of TYSON'S DELIVERY past mid stretch, kept on tenaciously under a drive and denied an outer GREAT COMPOSER through the final yards. GREAT COMPOSER rated inside while not far back, remained patient past the five sixteenths, angled four wide four the drive, worked between runners near mid stretch then closed gamely outside the winner. WORK FROM HOME was taken off the inside early and settled outside GREAT COMPOSER, angled five wide advancing into the stretch, ranged up outside rivals in mid stretch then churned on. TYSON'S DELIVERY stalked off the inside, edged up into the far turn, bid three deep after six furlongs, battled on near even terms outside the winner heading to the furlong grounds, failed to kick on with a sixteenth to go and faded. ROBERT'S MOON, a bit keen while saving ground stalking the pace, had aim off the embattled trio of leaders nearing the quarter pole, checked off heels then stumbled entering the lane, regrouped past the three sixteenths, drifted in a bit nearing the sixteenth pole then flattened under some hand encouragement. THE MAN TO SEE prompted the pace outside the winner, bid to apply more pressure into the far turn, dueled between runners past the five sixteenths, failed to go on past the three sixteenths and weakened. JADON'S HONOR was outrun.
