SOCIALLY AWKWARD , perched four then three wide off the dueling leaders, cruised up and bid three deep nearing the five sixteenths, took control past the three sixteenths, responded to firm asking and steadily pulled away. MY REDEMPTION , in range two wide and to the inside of a rival, angled four to five wide for the drive, straightened away and finished with interest. FLUFF THE PILLOW edged up along the rail into the first turn and got engaged in a duel with SPINNING HEART, carried that through the backstretch and into the far turn, stayed on inside a pair of rivals from the five sixteenths to upper stretch, fought on past mid stretch then faded late. SPINNING HEART got locked up to the outside of FLUFF THE PILLOW entering the first turn, gained a slim advantage between runners leaving the three eighths, drifted out when unable to go on leaving mid stretch and weakened. NAZARENO , three wide, chased outside a rival through the backstretch run and weakened.
