LAUGHING FIT , perched three deep off of a contested pace, bid leaving the far turn, vied then was roused clear approaching the stretch, opened up under a drive in mid stretch, wandered outward in deep stretch then held sway. SHE GOT THE MUNNI broke a step slow, raced three wide around the first turn, drafted inside near the half then edged up leaving the far turn, came back out with pursuit in upper stretch, straightened away and closed steadily. LITTLE MISS LINDA took over inside foes into the first turn then briefly cleared, dueled to the inside of HIGH ACHIEVER from the five eighths, stayed on as the winner made it a three ply scrum departing the far turn, shifted out with pursuit entering the stretch and finished with effort. HIGH ACHIEVER prompted the pace outside LITTLE MISS LINDA into and around the first turn, moved to apply more pressure leaving the three quarter pole then dueled, gained a slim lead while hustled between foes leaving the three eighths, chased the winner from the head of the lane to mid stretch then faded towards the inside. STRONG DECISION broke outward grazing her stall, had her rider adjust the right iron, saved ground past the seven eighths then steadied when in a bit close entering the backstretch, worked outward around the final turn but failed to generate the needed run. LADY LEMONCELLO, bumped at the break, lost ground four wide into the backstretch, chased outside a rival leaving the three eighths and weakened through the final furlong.
