Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

MS. LAOBANNIANG raced in range inside, was roused in the two path midway around the turn, swung from the three path into the lane, got herded out in the final furlong, but stayed on to draw past the inner pacesetter late. COLLECTED MIST got bumped by an inner foe at the start, set the pace in the two path, stayed on in the three path entering the stretch, but drifted out in the final furlong, and got nabbed by an outer foe in the final strides. FAHNEE stalked in the two path, was coaxed along in the three path around the turn, and finished evenly from the five path down the lane. HUMORESQUE trailed in the two path early but rallied up the rail down the stretch. SANDY GIRL tracked in the two path but was one paced in the three path down the lane. NEED A MIRACLE raced off the pace in the two path, fanned out to the six path at the top of the stretch, and steadily gained. AMELIORATE broke out and bumped an outer foe, raced in midpack in the two path, drifted out to the eight path in upper stretch, and faded. GOLDEN DANCER had a slow start, was wellback in the three path and never threatened. BEACH QUEEN chased in the four path but weakened.
