### Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

BIG BEEMSTER bumped with an inner foe at the start, showed the way in the two path, got put under pressure entering the far turn, lost the lead to an outer foe at the top of the lane, but dug in gamely to fight back going by the furlong grounds, took command again before the sixteenth, and held safe. ICE BAR hopped at the start, trailed while being nudged along in the two path up the backstretch, was driven into the far turn, passed a tired outer pair nearing the quarter, angled out to the seven path at the top of the stretch, and rallied outside of foes to get up for place late. GUNS N' ROJAS bumped with an outer foe at the start, stalked in the three path, was roused into the far turn, bid after the quarter, took the lead at the top of the lane, kept on but drifted out after the eighth pole, lost the lead before the sixteenth, then evened out late, but held show. COPPERHEAD CREEK bumped with an inner foe at the start, rated in the three path, was driven into the far turn, took aim while swinging out to the five path at the top of the stretch, stayed on into the final furlong, but flattened in the final sixteenth. SHANGHAI SUPERFLY bumped with an outer foe at the start, tracked in the two path, was coaxed along the inside entering the far turn, angled out to the five path in upper stretch, but weakened in the final furlong. OFF THE MEDS chased in the four path but made no closing bid. SWING OIL raced off the pace in the five path but never threatened.
